I mentioned last Sunday that those who followed this generous "wrecking crew" and worked on restoring the floor-tile beneath the carpet by removing the residue of the glue and cleaning it up were Mitch Dugan and Theresa Simpson. Also, with Mitch spending the necessary time on the floor this week as he did, Mike Bruno and Dutch Franklin stepped in to help Mitch out by mowing the lawn of our Stations of the Cross garden. I give thanks to both of them as I see for myself how much Annunciation truly lives and acts as a family.

The plan going forward now is still to be discussed and determined. The Parish Council and I will be discussing the possibilities for the future of the floor, so if you have anything you would like to share or ask please feel free to speak to anyone of them or myself about it. For the immediate future, the floors will be cleaned and waxed and brought to a shine making our house of worship as beautiful as she can be.

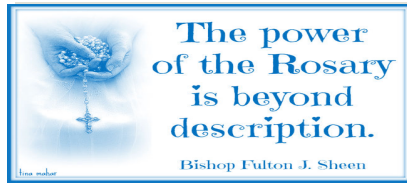
