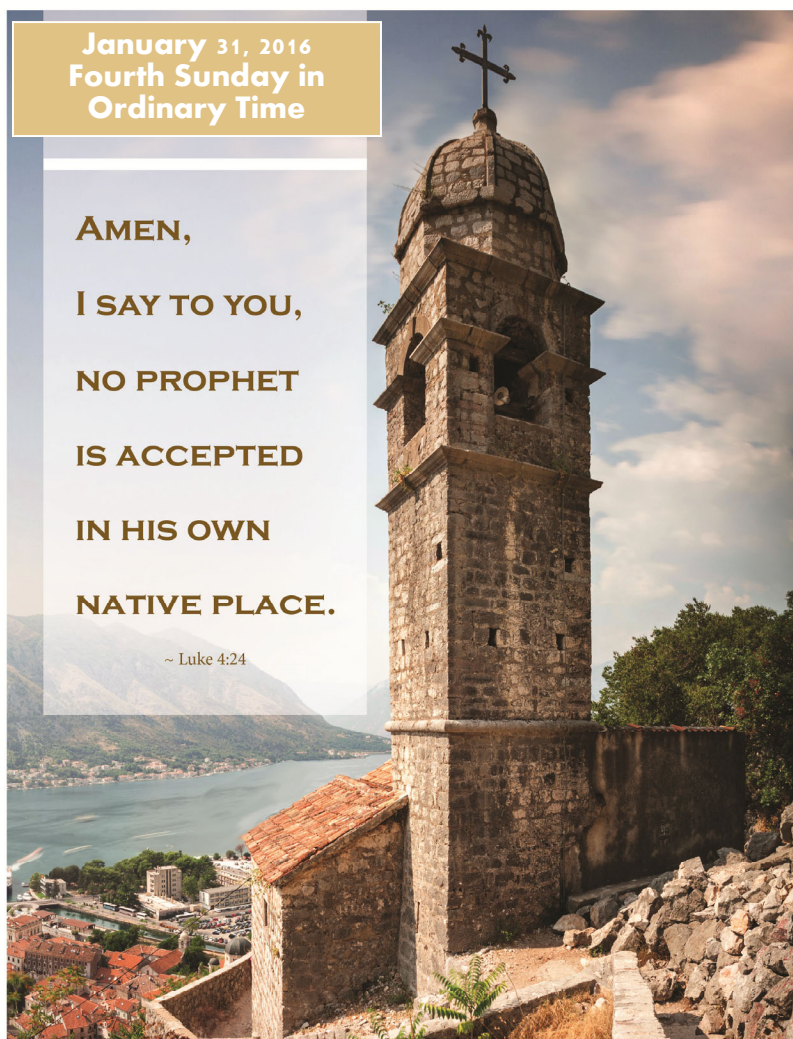

Dear Parishioners,

I had mentioned last weekend at all of our Masses that we had received wonderful news from Archbishop Carlson that St. Dominic Savio parish has been accepted into the Holy Cross Academy system. Over the past several months, the leaders of St. Dominic had been consulting with their parishioners, the pastors of Holy Cross parishes, the HCA board, and representatives of the Archdiocesan School Office. The consensus of all these meetings was that St. Dominic's commitment to providing quality Catholic education would be best served by joining the Holy Cross system. The addition of another parish to our school community will also strengthen and benefit our parishes by bolstering the enrollment in the middle school located here at Annunciation and enlarging the pool from which Holy Cross draws its students.

This new partnership will not change much for our current students and families. St. Dominic will be the site for another pre-k-5th grade campus and most of the students currently enrolled there will remain at that site. The next few months will be filled with meetings to welcome these new families into Holy Cross, answer questions, give tours and host 'shadow days' for new students, hire faculty and staff, and attend to the details of bringing another member into the current infrastructure of Holy Cross Academy.

Collaboration between parishes is the future of Catholic education and ministry. We are able to accomplish far more together than we could by ourselves as individual parishes. Please keep all of the parents, students, faculty and staff of St. Dominic Savio and Holy Cross Academy in your prayers during this time of transition asking our Lord to bless us as we move forward together towards a bright future.






