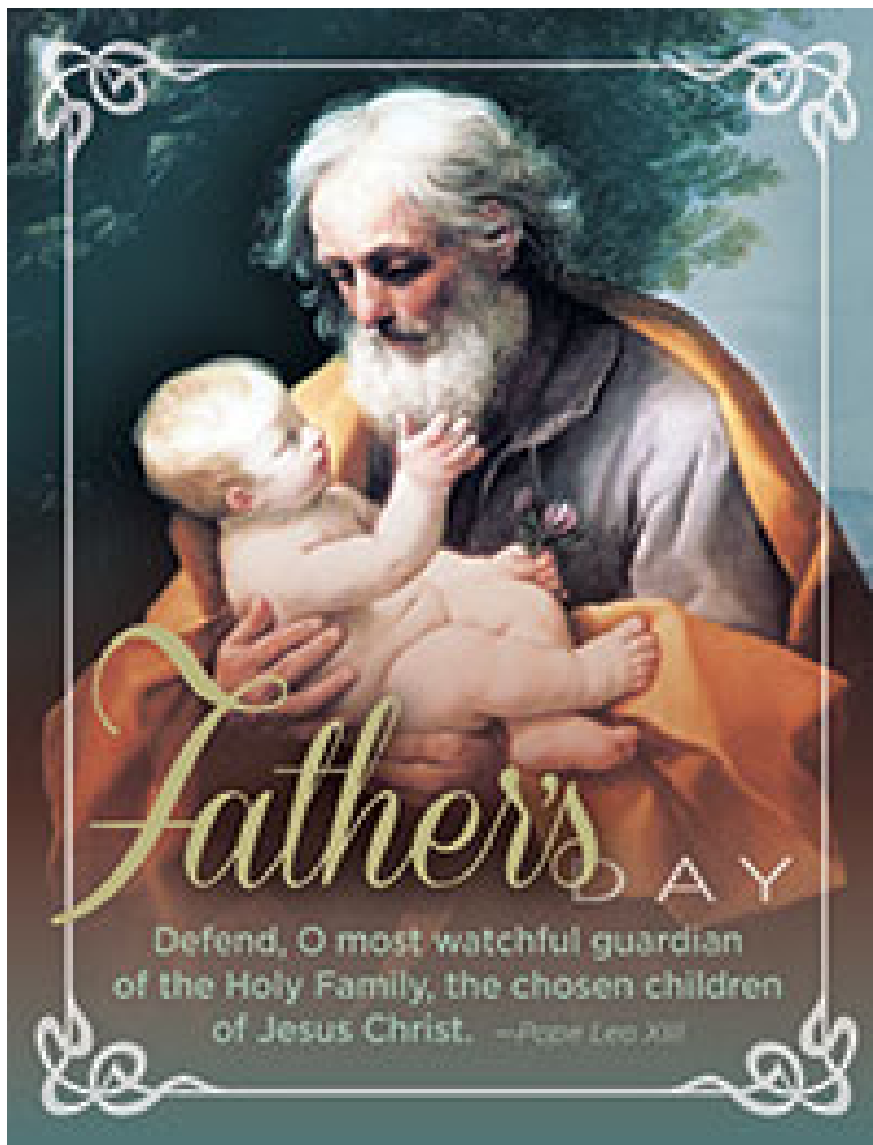

Dear Parishioners,

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY to all of our Dads and Grandpas of our Parish! May you have a wonderful Sunday and know of the many blessings of being a Dad.

Recently a gentleman named Cedric has been frequenting our parish seeking financial assistance for gas and food. We have assisted him numerous times and we were happy to do so seeking to live out Jesus' Law of love for our neighbor. A number of you have met him on our parking lot and you, too, have responded generously to him. Unfortunately, he has not always been honest with us and is also known to frequently visit and ask for similar assistance at other parishes and churches. We have given him guidance in the steps he needs to take in order to receive any future assistance through our St. Vincent De Paul Society, but he continues to come and ask for more and he can be very persuasive in asking and telling his story. In the event that he would approach you when you're here at the parish, I would ask for you to simply give him the number of our **St. Vincent De Paul Society 314-289-6101 x2255**. We will continue to print this number in our bulletin for your future reference so you are able to direct him and/or others you may meet in need of assistance in a good and reliable way. If after giving him this number he continues to ask you for money, which he may very likely do, please simply be gracious to him and say that this is all you can offer him, although be sure to sincerely say a prayer for him before you go to bed that night. If you're like me, you find situations like these very difficult and uncomfortable in knowing what is the Christian thing to do. We want to help and we want to love like Jesus. We do not want to ignore or neglect someone in need who we know that only by the grace of God that could be me. That's why it's good if we have an internal struggle going on within us when we see someone before us in need, and it's why it should alarm us if we do not. When a person stands before us asking for money, no matter what the truth of their situation may really be, first and foremost we must look upon them with love. We must look at them and see them for who they truly are, despite all the other details in the given circumstance, and see them as another person, another one of God's children. Sometimes we may give them food, sometimes a ride to the gas station, sometimes a listening ear and heart. This particular time I recommend to you, and for the good of all of us involved, that you give him the phone number along with your respect and a prayer that night before you go to bed.

Related to this in some way, please know that there will be two upcoming presentations and social justice forums (the first in August) on Health and Wealth Disparities that will be hosted by Holy Redeemer. We will be posting more information as it becomes available.

In other news....

In this month of June our Parish Council has completed another year of their service to our parish. I would like to thank three of the members who have completed their 3 year terms and are now retiring: Andy Dawson, Tony Hinrichs and Rick Wedel. 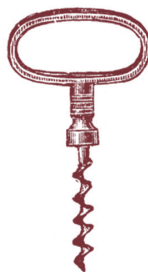
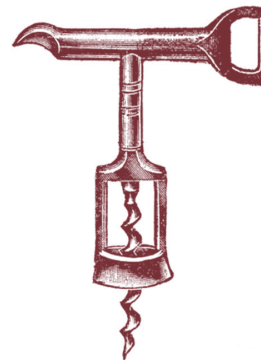
There was a wonderful turnout of over 40 men & wom-

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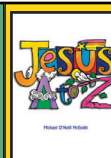
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
