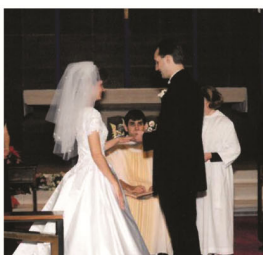
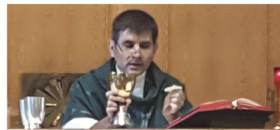

Interested in sending your 4-7 yr old children to Children's Liturgy?

Liturgy of the Word is a special liturgy available at 10:00 am Mass beginning July 17th. Each week a theme that correlates to the Sunday readings and Gospel is presented to the children using age appropriate materials.

The adult catechists incorporate prayer, song, group discussion, worksheet, and other activities so the children can relate the Word of God to daily life.

The children depart from the front of church after a blessing from the priest prior to the first reading, gather in the school building for the lesson, & return during offertory.

Becoming a catechist for Children's Liturgy of the Word is a great way to get involved in the Parish in a simple and fun way. Materials are provided including a lesson plan and handout for a 20 minute class.

2016 - Soccer Referees Needed/Returning Referees Training

The South Central CYC is in need of Soccer Referees for the upcoming fall soccer season. The requirements for NEW referees for this PAID position are as follows:


- You must be 14 years old by August 1, 2016
- Attend classroom clinic on either Wed 7/27 or Sun 8/14 at Sacred Heart - Valley Park from 6 - 9pm.
- Attend the field training on Wed 8/17 from 6-8pm at St. Gerard Majella
- Bring Cash/Check/Credit Card in the amount of \$31 to purchase referee jersey/pealess whistle and lanyard/ data wallet w/ pad and red and yellow cards. 3 stripe referee socks will also be available for purchase for \$6.
- Receive a score of 92% or above on the 2016 Soccer Official's Test
- Referees 18 years of age must meet additional archdiocesan requirements.

RETURNING referees must also receive a score of 92% or above on the 2016 Soccer Official's Test and are encouraged to attend a classroom clinic and on field training. 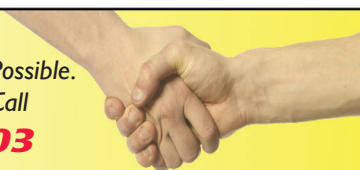
