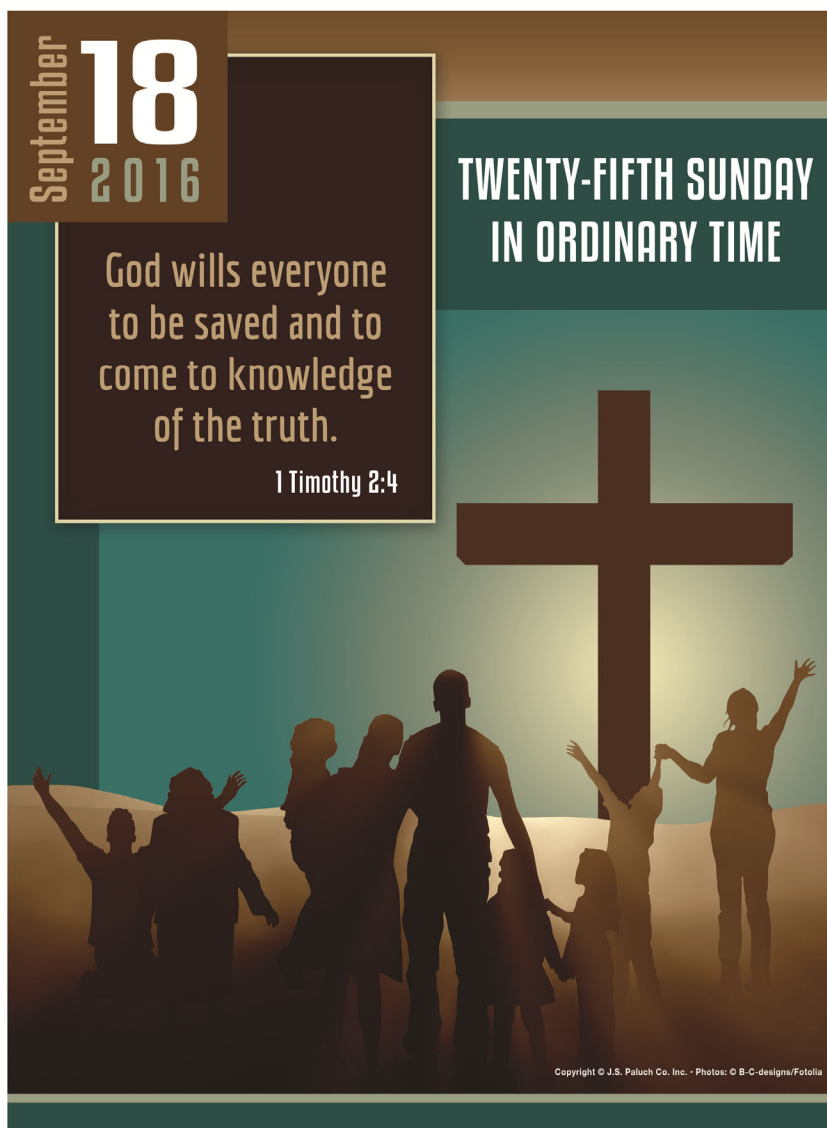

Dear Friends,

I mentioned the last two Sundays that our air conditioner in church wasn't working. Here's the current update –

We have four air handlers, essentially in the four corners of our church. Two weeks ago the one above the room directly behind our St. Joseph statue in the sanctuary developed a leaking valve. As a result, water from our air-conditioning system that circulates through the air handlers and back to the chiller (which is located in the maintenance building just next to the church in our Stations of the Cross Garden) leaked enough water through this “leaking valve” to run onto our floor and into the lower level of our cafeteria. This did some damage to the ceiling tiles of the boys bathroom in the cafeteria, as well as leaving a rust stain on the floor wherever the rusty water was able to sit for a while. In determining how to fix the leaky valve, asbestos was discovered around the pipes of all four air handlers. This week we were able to have the asbestos removed from all four. In the week ahead we look to have the leaking valve fixed and replaced. Proactively we will be addressing the very same issue with the other three before they have the opportunity to break on us. We have the expertise of the Archdiocese assisting us, as well as having received multiple assessments from different companies. I will be sure to keep you all informed of later developments but wanted to give you information on where we stand currently as you fan yourselves during Mass! I just keep thinking, "Thank God this is happening in September and not in June or July!"

Just a reminder – we are just beginning RCIA for this upcoming year so if you know of anyone who might be interested in learning more about our Catholic faith and who might be considering whether or not they would like to become Catholic, please let us know. I thank Patrick Stack for being our catechists and director of our RCIA program. Patrick has been leading this ministry for us here at Annunciation for a good number of years.

Also – don't forget about our upcoming Trivia Night on Saturday, October 15th, sponsored by our Men's Club. It should be fun and I hope you can be there!

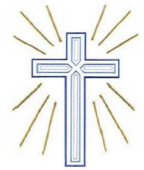

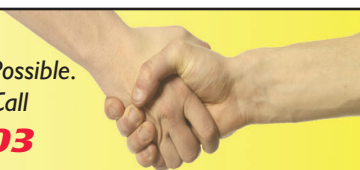
