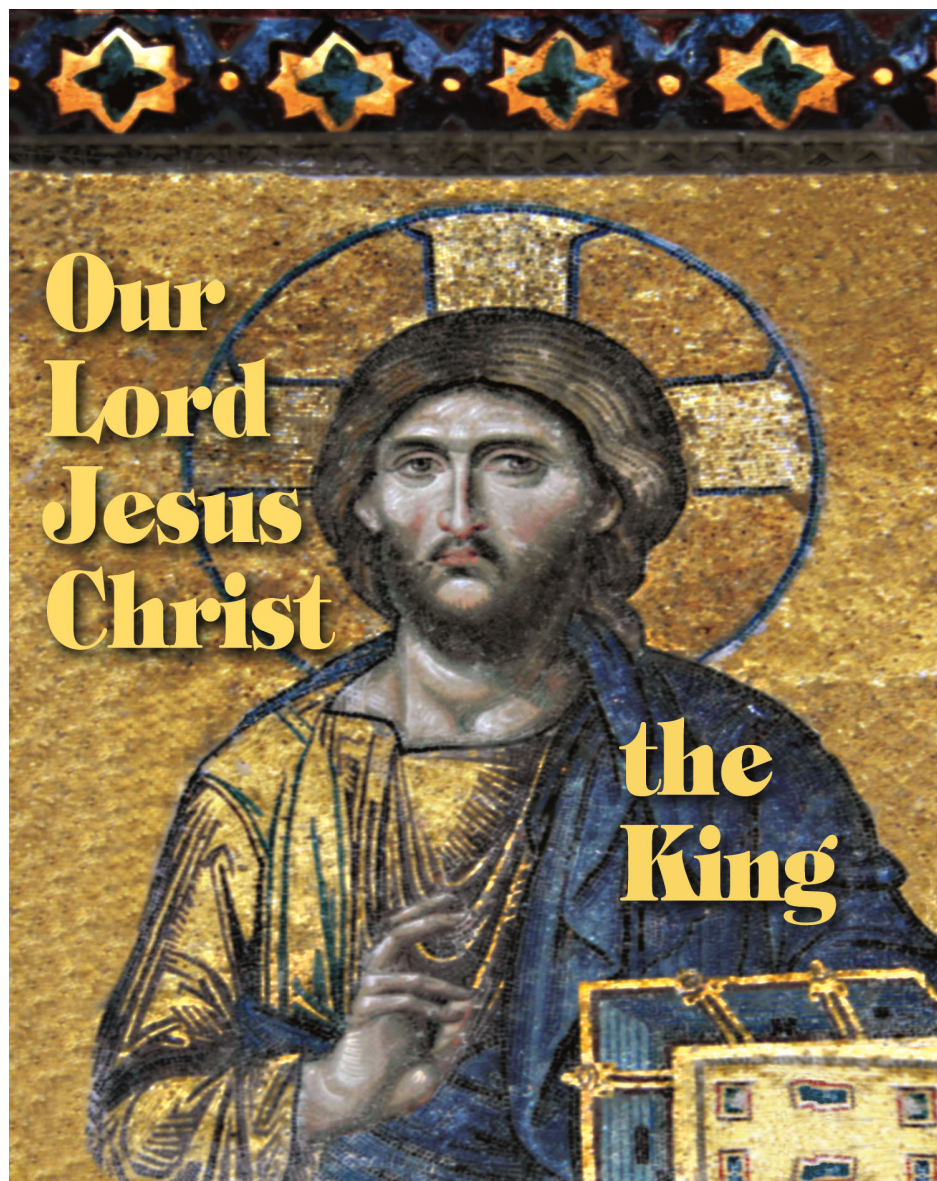

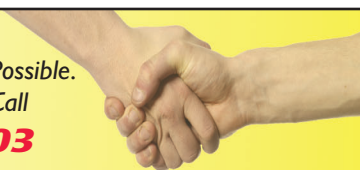
The Giving Tree is our way of sharing the Christmas message with those less fortunate members of Christ's family. Anyone wishing to participate can select an ornament from the tree, purchase that gift and place it in the boxes in the Bride's Room **unwrapped with the color coded ornament attached**. It is very important to attach the ornament, since we **sort the gifts by colors for the five agencies**. The agencies prefer that gifts are not wrapped since some let parents pick out gifts and other gifts are for the agencies to use over the course of the year. However, packages of gift wrapping and ribbons are most welcome by the St. Vincent de Paul and Feed My People groups.

The groups we are working with again this year are: St. Vincent de Paul chapter (red ornaments), South Side Day Care (yellow ornaments), Birthright (blue ornaments), Our Lady's Inn (pink ornaments) and Feed My People Seniors (orange ornaments). Gifts may be for individuals, families, groups of children or classrooms and there is a wide cost-range of gift ideas. Most items can be purchased at discount, craft or book stores or gift certificates (think APP).
