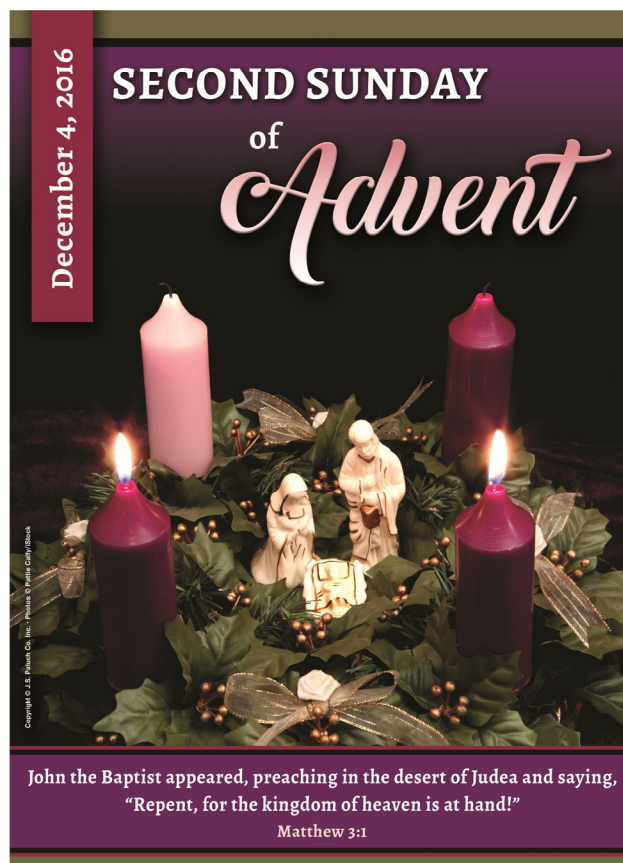

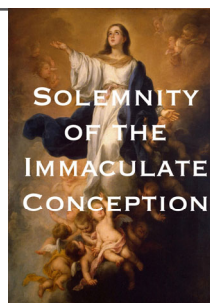

As we already enter into our second week of Advent, there are a couple of significant Feast Days coming our way to take note and be sure to remember.

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is this Thursday, December 8<sup>th</sup>. This is a Holy Day of Obligation for us as Our Lady, under her title of the Immaculate Conception, is the Patroness of our United States. God knows of our need for our dear Mother's prayers for us as a Nation, and our Mass times will be 6:30 am and 8:00 am (School Mass *but* all are welcome) and 7:00 pm. Please come and join us for Mass as you fulfill your obligation.

December 12th is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This apparition of Mary to Juan Diego back in the 1530s is a most fascinating story and holds great significance for us in the Americas. Liturgy of the Word is a special liturgy available at 10:00 am Mass. Each week a theme that correlates to the Sunday readings and Gospel is presented to the children using age appropriate materials. The adult catechists incorporate prayer, song, group discussion, worksheet, and other activities so the children can relate the Word of God to daily life.

The children depart from the front of church after a blessing from the priest prior to the first reading, gather in the school building for the lesson, and return during offertory.
