Dear Friends,

As we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany, a tradition in the Church is for families and individuals to bless their homes. For this blessing the family gathers at the front entrance, or their most used doorway of entry into their home, to ask God's blessing upon them who live there, as well as all those who will come and visit their home in the new year ahead. The blessing is an invitation for Jesus to be a daily guest in your home, your comings and goings, your conversations, your work and play, your joys and sorrows.

The traditional way of doing this is to use the blessed piece of chalk you received at church to write above your home's entrance, 20 + C + M + B + 17.

The letters C, M, B have two meanings. They are the initials of the traditional names of the three magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. They also abbreviate the Latin words *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "May Christ bless this house."

The "+" signs represent the cross and 2017 is the year.

Here is a brief prayer service you may use as a family to ask for the Lord's blessing upon you and your home--

Blessing of a Home at Epiphany

V. Our help is the name of the Lord:

R. The maker of heaven and earth.

V. The Lord shall watch over your going out and your coming in:

R. From this time forth for evermore.

Let us pray.

Loving God, bless our home with this chalk which you have created, that it may be helpful to us your people; and grant that through the invocation of your most Holy Name that we who use it in faith to write upon the door of our home the names of your holy ones Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar, may receive health of body and protection of soul for all who dwell in or visit our home; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Marking the lintel of your front doorway of your Home:

With the blessed chalk write as follows:

20 + C + M + B + 17 while saying:

The three Wise Men, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar followed the star of God's Son who became human two thousand and seventeen years ago.

May Christ bless our home and remain with us throughout the New Year. Amen.

Then offer the following prayer:

Visit, O blessed Lord, this home with the gladness of your presence. Bless all who live or visit here with the gift of your love; and grant that we may manifest your love to each other and to all whose lives we touch. May we grow in grace and in the knowledge and love of you; guide, comfort, and strengthen us in peace, O Jesus Christ, now and forever. Amen

With time the chalk will fade and as it does we are to let the meaning of the symbols written above our doors to sink into the depths of our hearts and be manifest in our words and actions, the Latin words, *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "May Christ bless this house."

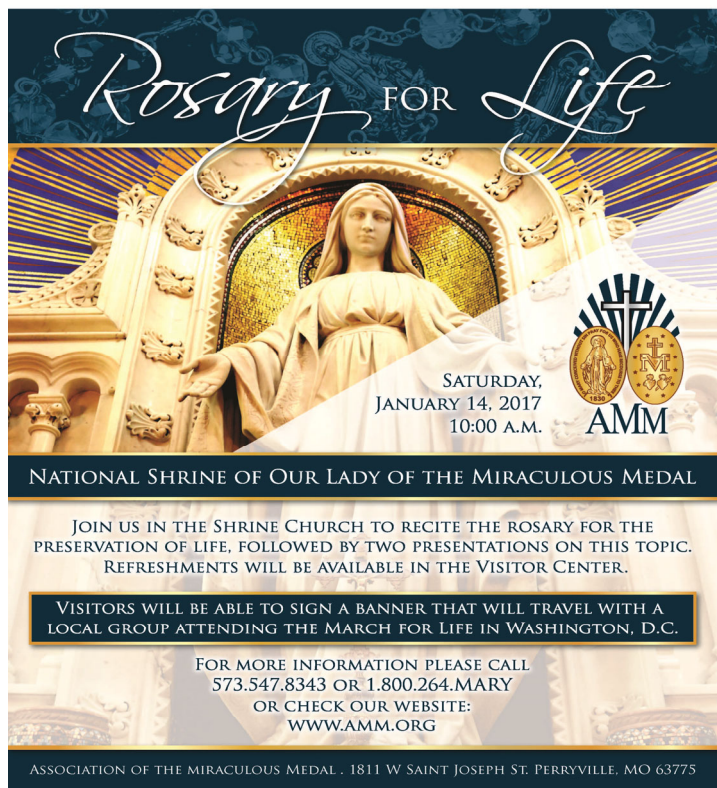
The children depart from the front of church after a blessing from the priest prior to the first reading, gather in the school building for the lesson, and return during offertory.

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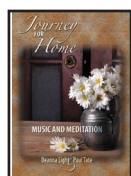


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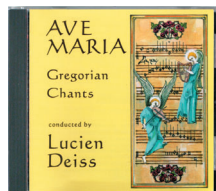
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
