Dear Friends-

How quickly Christmas came and went! We will now be in the Season of Ordinary Time for the next six weeks and then it will be Lent. Usually these weeks in Ordinary Time, between Christmas and Lent, are few in number. This year we will have a longer stay in 'Green' (Ordinary Time's liturgical color) since the Season of Christmas was shorter in length and Ash Wednesday has a later than average date of arrival, that being March 1st. Ordinary Time gets its name, not because these weeks are to be thought of as less important or uninteresting, but, rather, this Season gets its name from the Latin word *ordinalis*, which refers to 'numbers in a series'. It stems from the Latin word *ordo*, from which we get the English word *order*. Thus, the numbered weeks of Ordinary Time, in fact, represent the ordered life of the Church—the period in which we live our lives neither in feasting (as in the Christmas and Easter Seasons) nor in more severe penance (as in Advent and Lent), but in watchfulness and expectation of the Second Coming of Christ. There are a total of 33 or 34 Sundays in Ordinary Time, depending upon a given year, and it's always broken in two segments of time with Lent and Easter in between. As we give *number and order* to these weeks of Ordinary Time, may we also give count and number and thanks to God for the blessings and gifts that are ours!

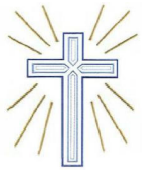

AUF ZU GOTT - CATHOLIC AND PROTESTANT ROOTS OF J.S. BACH'S ORGAN MUSIC. On Tuesday February 21, Dr. Andrzej Zahorski will present a program of organ music featuring organ works by J.S. Bach and by Catholic and Protestant composers who had exercised a formative influence on the great German composer at St. Joseph Chapel of Kenrick-Glennon Seminary. Johann Sebastian Bach was born in an era still painfully affected by sharp conflicts between Catholics and Protestants which culminated with the Thirty Year War. Catholic and Protestant musical cultures reflected that division and increasing separation. Bach, however, knew how to appreciate good music on both sides of the divide. Keyboard compositions by *Girolamo Frescobaldi* - an official organist at Vatican-had a direct impact on Bach's creative work. We also know that Bach copied by hand the entire collection of organ works by a chief representative of French Baroque organ school - *Nicolaus de Grigny*. Some works by these composers that will be performed are based on prayers that are in use by both denominations: Prayer to God the Father, (The Lord's Prayer), to the Son (Kyrie) and to the Holy Spirit (Come, Holy Ghost).

Liturgy of the Word is a special liturgy available at 10:00 am Mass. Each week a theme that correlates to the Sunday readings and Gospel is presented to the children using age appropriate materials. The adult catechists incorporate prayer, song, group discussion, worksheet, and other activities so the children can relate the Word of God to daily life.

The children depart from the front of church after a blessing from the priest prior to the first reading, gather in the school building for the lesson, and return during offertory.

- Individual students may not receive more than one scholarship if awarded. However, Catholic Families Tuition Assistance and Parish Employees Endowment Fund are tuition aid programs that may be awarded in addition to another scholarship. Families may have multiple children receiving scholarships.
- Documents needed to complete applications include:
 - High School Students are required to submit an essay and contact information for two references at the time of application to be considered for the *Beyond Sunday* Fellows Program. Students already receiving a *Beyond Sunday* Fellows scholarship are not required to submit an essay or references for requalification.
 - ESSAY PROMPT: In 250 words, please describe why you want to be a *Beyond Sunday* Fellow.
 - REFERENCES: One from your pastor or leader of a Catholic program or organization of which the applicant is a member, and the other from a teacher or principal. Please provide only the contact information for your references and do not submit letters of recommendation. Your references will only be contacted if necessary.
 - Proof of residency (St. Louis City residents only)
 - Proof of Income

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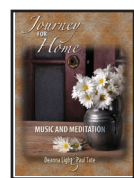


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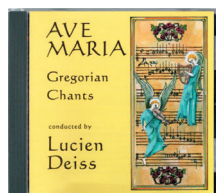
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
