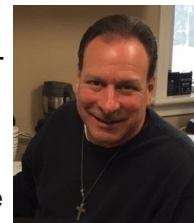


Dear Friends,

It was great that much of Bishop-elect's family was able to come, too. Their picture is included here in the bulletin as well as his letter of thanks. Do keep him in your prayers as we await his ordination as Bishop and his appointment as Auxiliary Bishop of Saint Louis.

Also I am happy to report of two new individuals who have accepted positions here at Annunciation and Holy Cross Academy.

First, please join me in welcoming Richard Hespen who is now our Maintenance Supervisor. If you are here during the week sometime, you may have the opportunity to meet him. His picture is included here in the bulletin.



Richard and his wife, Diane, are members of St. Angela Merici Parish. For the last 16 years, Richard had been employed at St. Ferdinand Catholic Church in Florissant as their Facility Manager. He has much experience and knowledge in the 'runnings' of a parish, and I look forward to him working here at a Annunciation. 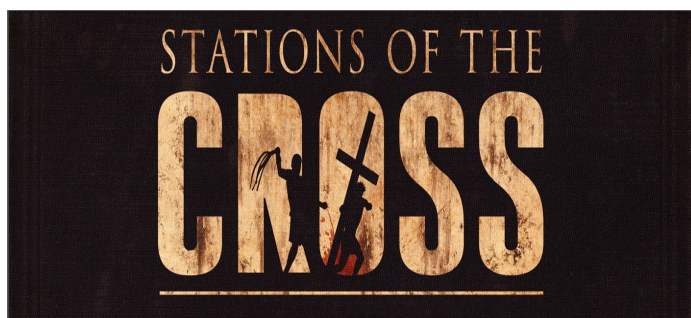

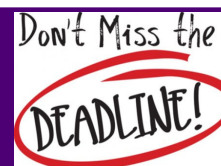
