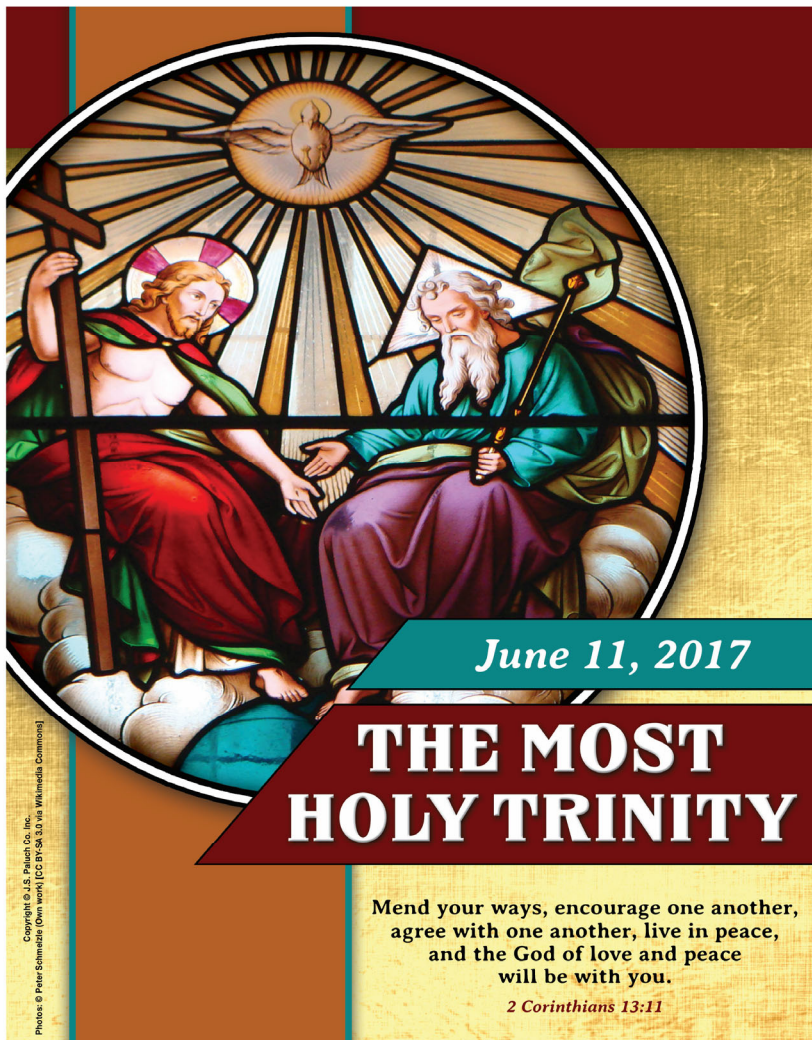

She has been the one who would regularly come to the rectory and review and track the gift cards that had been sold, place orders for new gift cards to be sold, and made sure with Barb Koch, our book keeper/secretary, that the balance of the gift cards remained accurate. After doing this for these many years she is now going to enjoy a well-deserved retirement! Of course, I am referring to her retiring only from coordinating "Together We're Better," but nothing else!

On behalf of all of us I extend a big THANKS to Katie for the many hours that she dedicated over these years towards raising money for Annunciation by way of 'Together We're Better'. We have certainly been blessed! Thank You.

As I thank all of them I want to take this opportunity to also remind everyone about this program and how it can so easily benefit us as a parish in significant, monetary ways. In quoting someone who has for years been faithfully taking advantage of using this program to purchase all of her family's groceries, "It's so easy to do and it can make a lot of money for Annunciation if everyone just understood how easy it was and were willing to take just a couple of minutes every now and then to stop after Mass and purchase the gift cards."

If by chance you have never given it much thought and do not understand how it works, it is rather simple and it has the potential to benefit us greatly depending upon the number of us who use it. While you can buy gift cards for many different restaurants and stores and use them for gifts for yourself, the biggest benefit probably comes from parishioners who purchase the gift cards for Schnucks, Dierbergs, and Shop'n Save, and then use them at the store rather than using their credit card or by writing a check. The way that this benefits us is that we receive a percentage of each gift card sold. Therefore, by purchasing gift cards that you will use to buy your groceries later that week or month, you lose nothing and Annunciation receives a percentage of your purchases that, otherwise, would have all gone to the grocery store. When many people do this it begins to add up quickly to a large amount of money for Annunciation Parish that we could use in many ways, such as paying our bills or covering the costs for facility improvements, a new hat for Bishop Rivituso (ha ha!), etc. Since everyone shops for groceries, it seems to be a good thing for all of us to consider doing when it comes to deciding how we each want to best purchase our groceries. And with that thought...

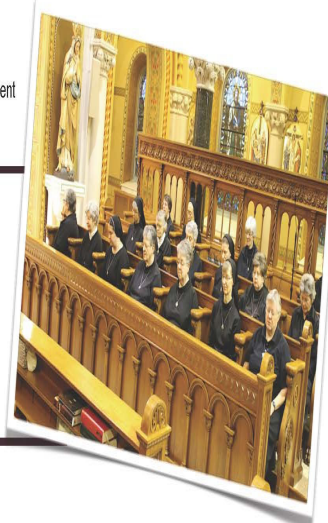

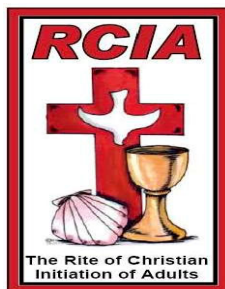

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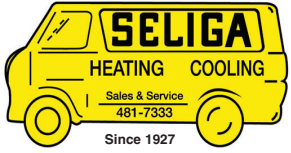
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
