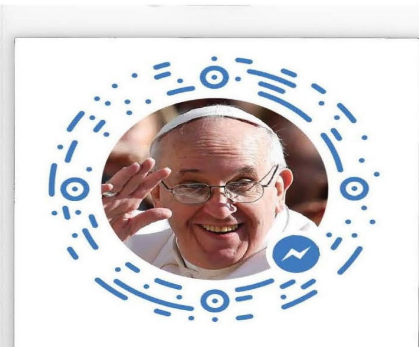

Next Sunday at 10 AM Mass we will bless our Parish Council members. In September the Council began its new year with four new members, for a total of 12 Parish Council members. If you attend this Mass you will be able to see and meet those who generously serve our parish in this leadership role.

Last week was the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Miracle of the Sun when our Blessed Mother appeared for her sixth and final apparition to the three shepherd children in Fatima. At that apparition Mary revealed herself as Our Lady of the Rosary and encouraged the children, and our world, to find refuge in her Immaculate Heart by praying the rosary for peace in the world and forgiveness of our sins. The events that took place in Fatima, as well as the defensive victory won in October of 1571 by Christian Europe through the intercession of our Lady of the Rosary, are reasons why October is designated as a month of Mary. May has been given this distinction, too. If you are not that familiar with the story of our Lady of Fatima, or the Battle of Lepanto, you may find it of interest to read more about them. Not only are these stories intriguing, but also they may gain us more appreciation for the power of our Mother Mary’s intercessory prayer, in particular, through us praying the rosary.

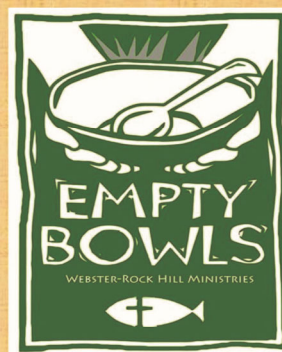


