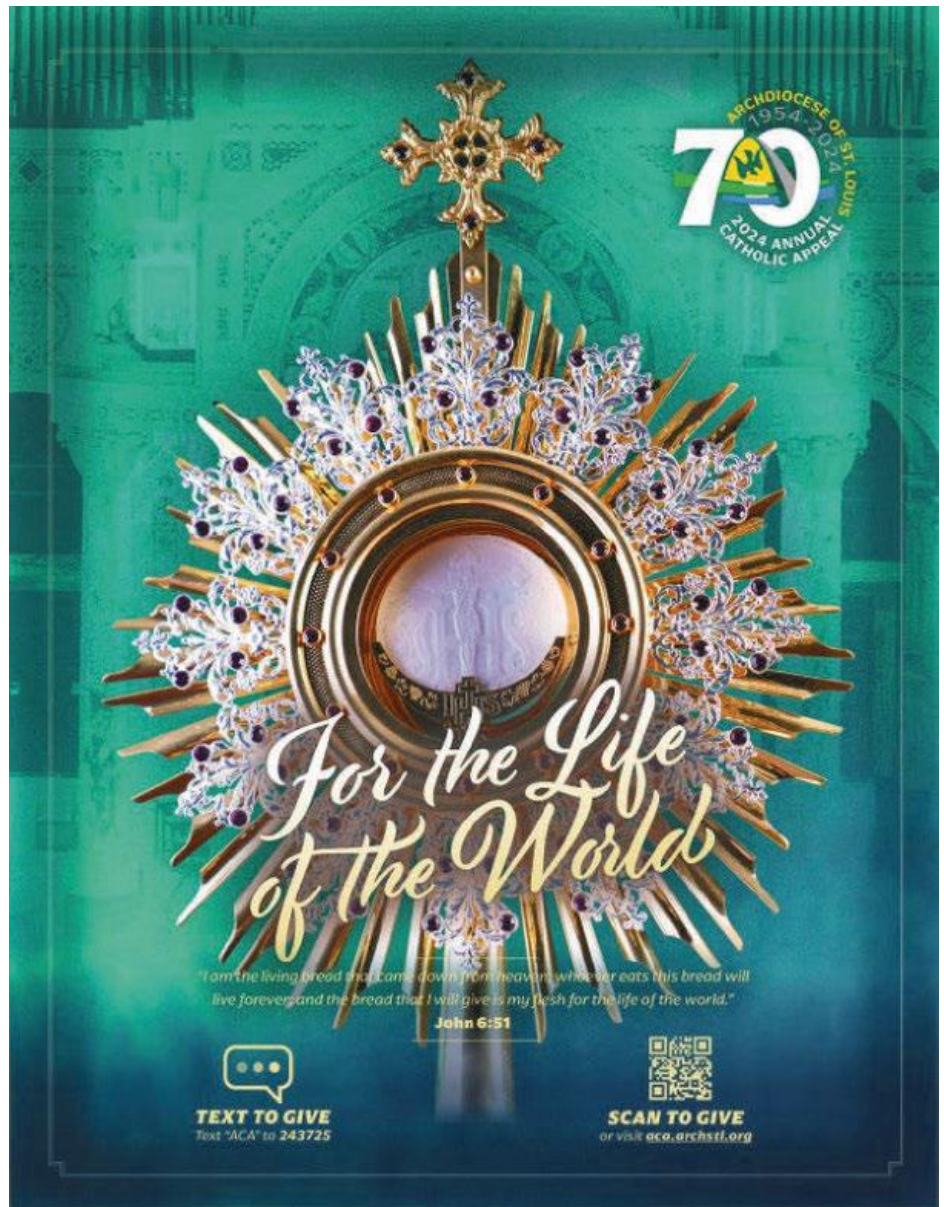

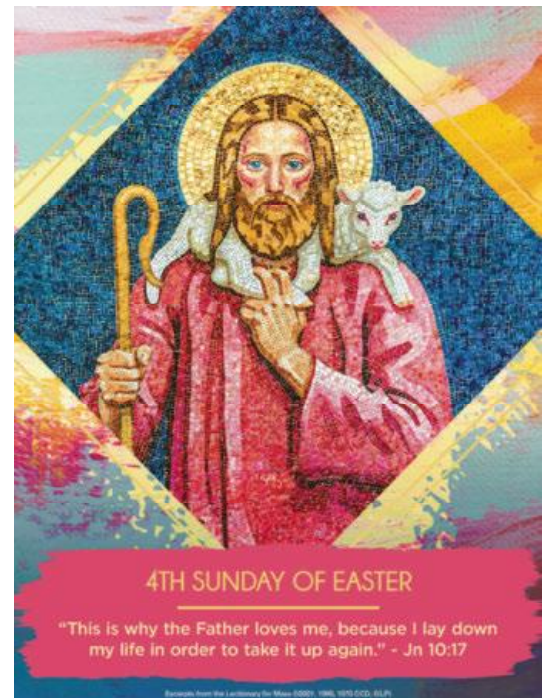

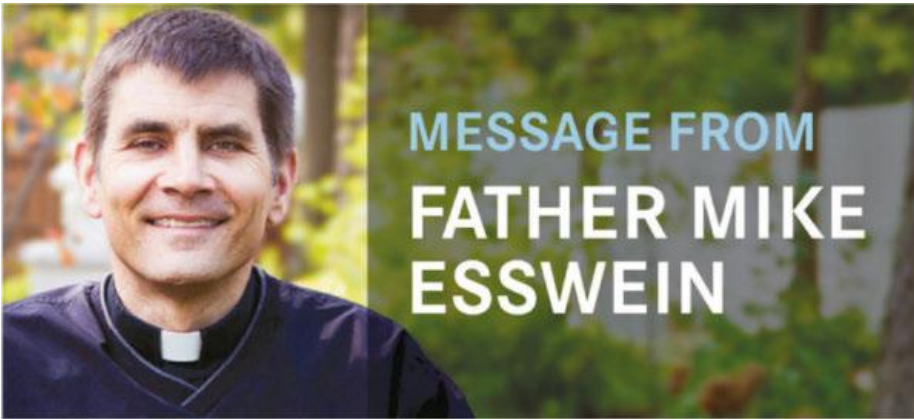

Dear Friends,

Every year at this time the Archdiocese holds the Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA). This capital campaign is supported throughout our local Church of St. Louis in every one of our parishes. This year's Appeal is *For the Life of the World*. The ACA provides us an opportunity to realize the difference we can make when we act together in God's love. The impact that it has on so many lives each year is significant. The ministries that rely on the Appeal are wide ranging and have a direct impact on the Church and our communities throughout the Archdiocese. 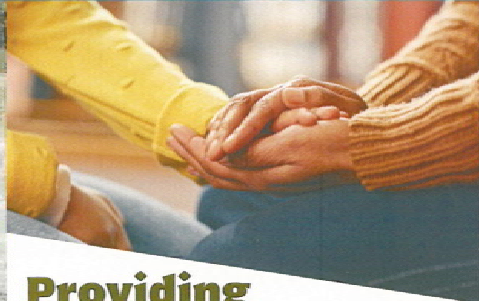

Father Klocker's Hybrid Tea Rose Garden

Annunciation is in need of someone to assume the leadership position of the Rose Garden

Club to continue the care and preservation of Father Klocker's hybrid tea rose garden. In addition, the club needs new members to join the existing team members. Hybrid Teas are beautiful; however, during the growing season from April to late November the roses need weekly care. This includes pruning and weeding before the Saturday evening mass, monitoring the watering as needed during the week with the irrigation system already in place, and granular fertilizing every three months. The health of the plants depend upon biweekly spraying for insects and black spot. After the first frost or in late fall, the entire team puts the plants "to bed" for the winter. 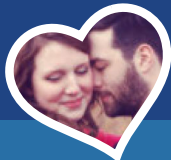
