Tax-Savvy Ways to Give

Did you know that making charitable donations can provide an array of tax benefits while helping to maximize the impact of your gifts?

Stock Gifts: If stocks or other publicly traded securities you have owned for more than a year increased in value since acquiring them, donating them to the *Annual Catholic Appeal* may help you eliminate capital gains taxes typically incurred when selling such assets. You may also be able to claim a charitable deduction for their current market value.

Donor Advised Funds (DAF): A donor-advised fund is a special account that allows donors to commit funds for charitable gifts now and make decisions on where they should go at a later date. The gift is eligible for a tax deduction for the year in which money is placed in the fund and can potentially grow tax free. Many financial firms, including the Roman Catholic Foundation of Eastern Missouri, offer these accounts, and the *Annual Catholic Appeal* has seen an increase in DAF gifts in recent years.

MAKE A DIFFERENCE TODAY AND SAVE ON TAXES

Individual Retirement Account (IRA) Gifts: If you are at least 70 ½ years old, you can make income tax-free gifts of any amount (up to a maximum of \$100,000 per year) from your IRA directly to the *Annual Catholic Appeal*. Your disbursement must come directly from the administrator of your IRA to the *Annual Catholic Appeal*.

RMD: If you are 73 or older and have an Individual Retirement Account (IRA), you must annually withdraw a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). RMDs are typically reported as taxable income, but a gift to the *Annual Catholic Appeal* made directly from your IRA can be counted toward your RMD, lowering your gross income and gross IRA contributions.



Your benefits can vary based on your individual tax situation. Please consult your tax advisor for details or with any tax or account-specific questions.

Father Klocker's Hybrid Tea Rose Garden

Annunciation is in need of someone to assume the leadership position of the Rose Garden

Club to continue the care and preservation of Father Klocker's hybrid tea rose garden. In addition, the club needs new members to join the existing team members. Hybrid Teas are beautiful; however, during the growing season from April to late November the roses need weekly care. This includes pruning and weeding before the Saturday evening mass, monitoring the watering as needed during the week with the irrigation system already in place, and granular fertilizing every three months. The health of the plants depend upon biweekly spraying for insects and black spot. After the first frost or in late fall, the entire team puts the plants "to bed" for the winter. 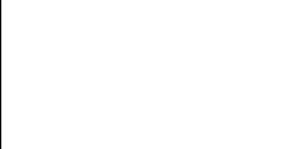
