Bible Blessing Family Night

Our 3rd and 6th Grade families recently gathered in church with Fr. Mike, Ms. Amy Buehrle (Adult Faith Formation Coordinator for PSR), and Mrs. Ann Kelly (PSR Director) for a family night where the students received their new Bibles and a blessing from Fr. Mike. Families learned about praying Scripture through Visio Divina ('Divine Seeing'). This is similar to Lectio Divina ('Divine Reading'), but in addition to hearing the Word of God for meditation and contemplation, one also reflects on an artist's depiction of the Scripture reading through illuminated images. After reading the story of Creation, they were drawn deeper into the Word of God through sharing what they saw in the image. It was a wonderful discussion, and the students are excited to use their Bibles to PSR each week.
