Dear Friends,

In last week's bulletin I explained that beginning in mid-July we would be replacing the roof of the parish center. I mentioned that the cost for this much needed repair to our facilities was a little more than \$100,000 and that it was going to be covered with the funds we had previously raised through the Beyond Sunday Campaign. In order for us to get to this point of actually replacing the roof, it first involved getting an assessment for all of the roofs of our facilities, reviewing and discussing our options, getting bids, and, then, finally choosing the roofing company for the job before getting it scheduled in a timely manner. The members of our Facility Committee are the individuals who have done all of this preliminary work and I am most grateful to each of them for their stewardship of our parish in this way.

Since forming this committee a year ago they have been instrumental in assisting me and our maintenance supervisor in accomplishing a number of facility repairs and improvements, as well as making plans for our facilities in the near future.

Some of these improvements and repairs have been --

- All of the trees throughout our entire campus have been trimmed and made safe from the potential hazard of dangerous, falling branches.
- There was tuck pointing done to correct structural issues to the corners of the Parish Center, the backside of the school and around the large, circle-stained glass window in church.
- If you have ever attended any event in our cafeteria during the colder months of the year and experienced the room to be very warm while even the windows were wide open, this should now be a thing of the past! It was determined that if the boiler pipes running along the ceiling throughout the cafeteria were insulated it would eliminate the common, overheating experience. It also improves the heating efficiency of the church. Good news!
- The water isolation valves throughout the old school were replaced which provides the benefit for maintaining all the restroom plumbing without having to shut down the whole system. This is important if/when it becomes necessary to immediately address a plumbing issue in the school, it will not require the shutting off of our entire plumbing system and force us to close school for the remainder of the day. Sorry kids!
- Securing an incentive grant from AmerenUE that allowed us to, most recently, upgrade all of our lights to LED lights throughout the school and parish center, the rectory, and all of our outside lights. The savings in our energy costs will pay us back within one and one-half years for the amount we had to spend on purchasing the new LED lights.
- The rectory offices have been renovated with new carpet and paint
- And this summer the MPH and ANNUNCIATION Meeting Rooms will be renovated with much needed new carpet and paint.

In the church—

- All the lights in church had also just been replaced this year with LED lights and we installed an improved lighting control system.
- A pipe that provides water to the Baptismal font was discovered to be leaking and was replaced
- The face of the altar was enhanced with a stone addition, a mosaic and lighting
- The clouded window of the vestibule that was prominently visible in the front of church was replaced

In the area of safety measures in school—

- All of our outdated smoke detectors have been replaced
- New locks for all classrooms to meet new standards specifically in regards to safety from an intruder are being installed this summer.


As you can see a number of really good things have happened to our facilities within this past year and all of the expenses have been covered through our funds from the Beyond Sunday campaign and our annual Mardi Gras Parish fundraiser run by our Parish Council. I am happy to point out these many good things that benefit the physical well being of our parish home, as we always look and hope to grow and improve the well being of our spiritual lives and home on earth that is to lead us to our eternal home of heaven!

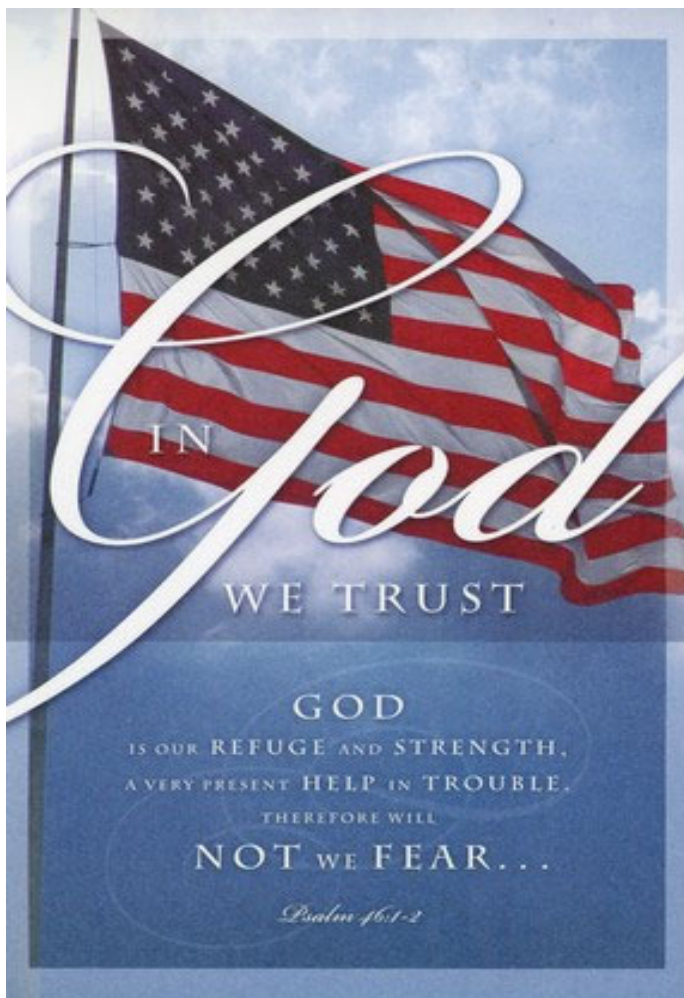





2018 - CYC ADULT AND YOUTH SOCCER REFEREES NEEDED

The South Central CYC is in need of Soccer Referees for the upcoming fall soccer season.

The requirements for NEW referees for this PAID position are as follows:


- You must be 14 years old by August 1, 2018
- Attend classroom clinic on **EITHER** Wed 7/18 **OR** Sun 7/29 at Sacred Heart - Valley Park from 6 - 10pm (use gym entrance, session will be held in the Great Hall).
- Attend field training on **EITHER** Wed 8/1 from 6-7:30pm **OR** Sat 8/18 from 9-10:30am at Memorial field in Webster Groves (corner of S. Elm and E. Glendale)
- Bring Cash/Check/Credit Card to purchase referee jersey/pealess whistle and lanyard/data wallet w/ pad and red and yellow cards. 3 stripe referee socks will also be available for purchase.
- Receive a score of 92% or above on the 2018 Soccer Official's Test
- Referees 18 years of age must meet additional archdiocesan requirements.

RETURNING referees must also receive a score of 92% or above on the 2018 Soccer Official's Test and are encouraged to attend a classroom clinic and on field training. Classroom clinic is required for returning referees that score <92% on the official's test.

Pay ranges from \$15/game for K-2 games to \$30/game for 7th-8th grade games.

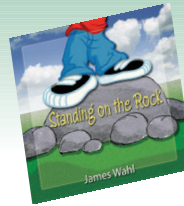

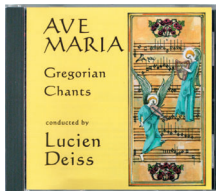
