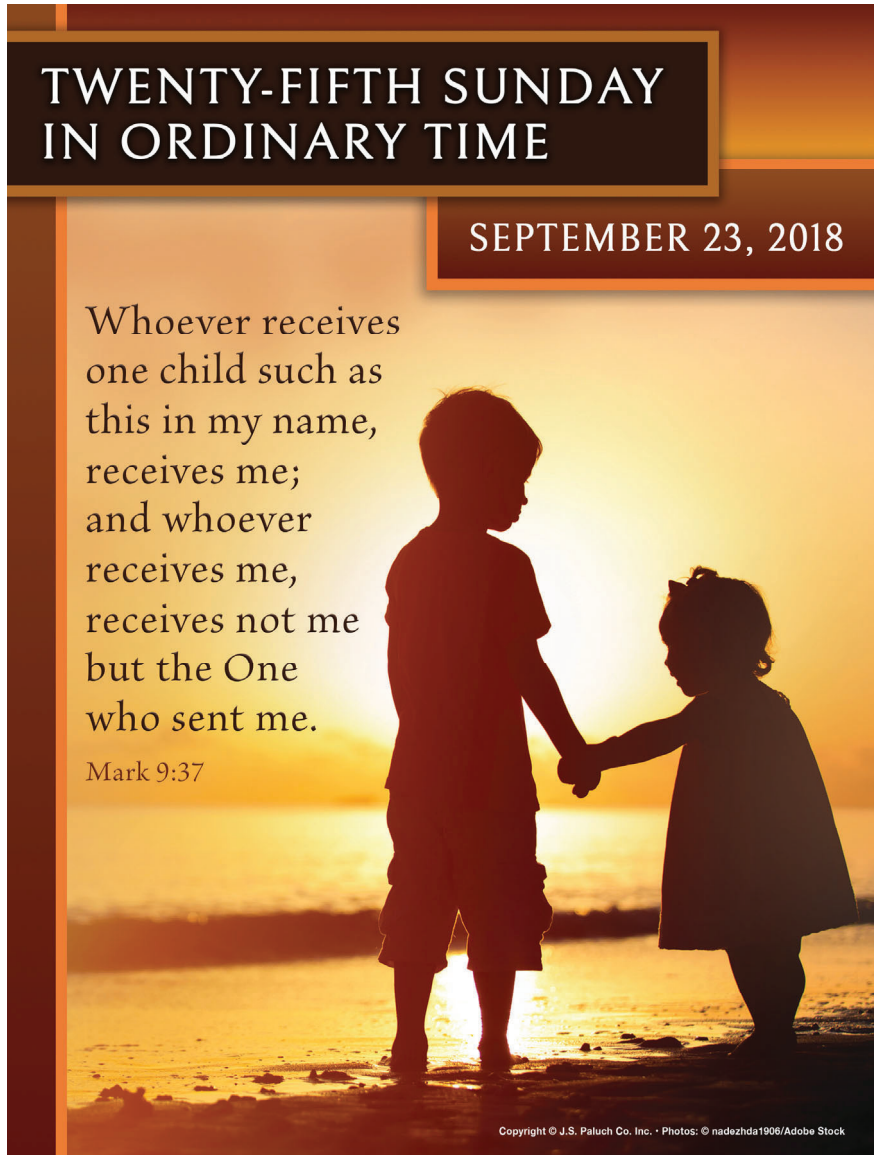

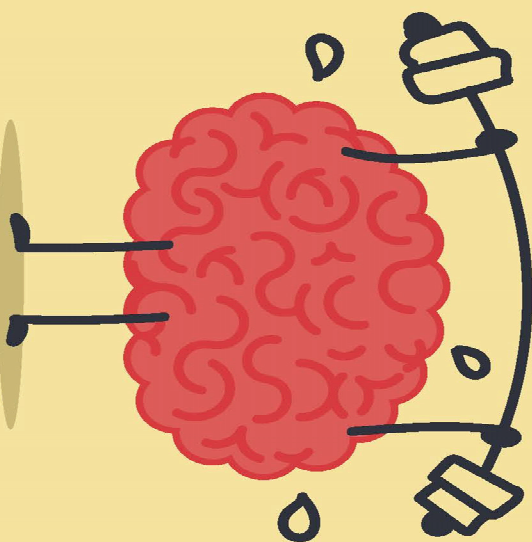

Dear Friends,

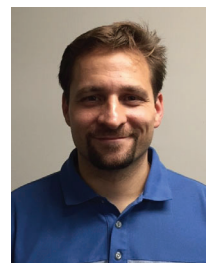
In a couple weeks on Saturday, October 13th I will have a meeting with everyone who serves as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (Eucharistic Ministers) for our parish. There will be time given for some faith formation as well as time spent on reviewing our practical, concrete procedures and discussing some changes for this ministry. If you are not already an Extraordinary Minister but have interest in serving our parish in this ministry, please be sure to come to this meeting as this will be the time to learn!

Please note that to be an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion one must be:

- At least 18 yrs of age
- Have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist
- If married, must have been in the Church by a priest or deacon
- Someone divorced is equally welcomed to serve in this ministry, *again, but cannot have been remarried outside of the Church.*

We will meet in church at 9am and donuts will be included! Please be sure to put it in your calendars.

I am happy to report that our new Maintenance Supervisor, Chris Lowe, began officially working here at Annunciation this past week! 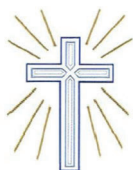

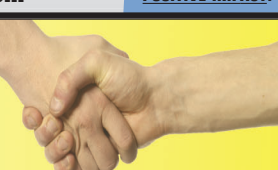
