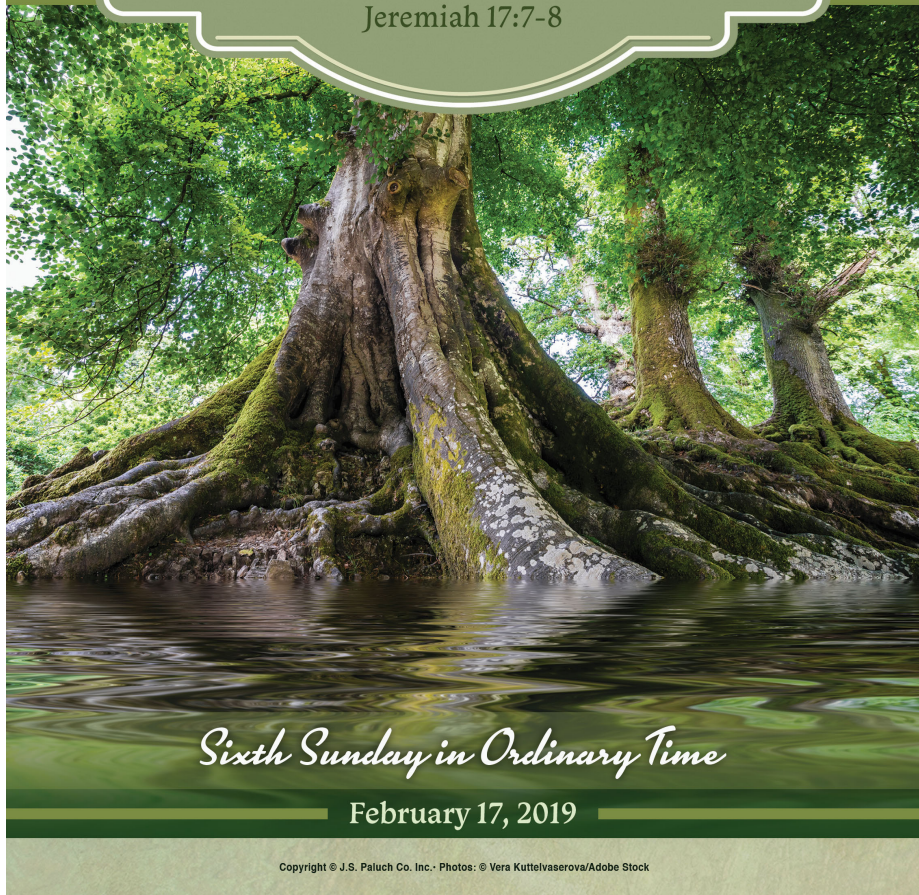

MESSAGE FROM FATHER MIKE ESSWEIN

Dear Friends,

This past Monday the Parish Council got together for its monthly meeting. In addition to discussing the current events, the needs, and the goals of our parish during these monthly meetings, there is also a small segment of time dedicated to personal faith formation.

For this month's formation we considered St. Ignatius' Daily Examen. Everyone is familiar with Saint Ignatius of Loyola or at least the religious community he founded, the Society of Jesus, better known as the Jesuits. Saint Ignatius developed and practiced a spirituality that is now known as Ignatian spirituality. Ignatian spirituality is spirituality for everyday life. It insists, as does our faith, that God is present in our world and active in our daily lives. At the core of living this spirituality is the Daily Examen that is now a 500-year-old wisdom tradition in the Church that St. Ignatius developed himself. It is a technique of prayerful reflection on the events of a person's day in order to detect God's presence and discern the direction God desires for him or her to go. The Examen can empower a person to make good decisions as keen discernment is brought into light where before it most likely was unnoticed or indiscernible. It is an easy, simple, and straightforward method of prayer that is accomplished in minutes of time and is one of the few rules of prayer that Saint Ignatius made for each member of the Jesuit order to practice twice daily—at noon and at the end of the day.

One of my favorite websites is **IgnatianSpirituality.com**. I recommend and encourage each of you to go to this website and look at the countless offerings it has on the Daily Examen. There are not only articles that can provide understanding of this method of prayer, but there are reflections and videos that will guide you through an actual experience of an Examen. Even more, these personal guides have been created for every time of day, every experience in life and every emotion known to us as human beings. This website is also a source for podcasts and blogs that will not only make Ignatian spirituality understandable and applicable to life, but potentially reveal to you a more certain prayer path to a better, happier and more peaceful life. When you get a chance, go take a look!

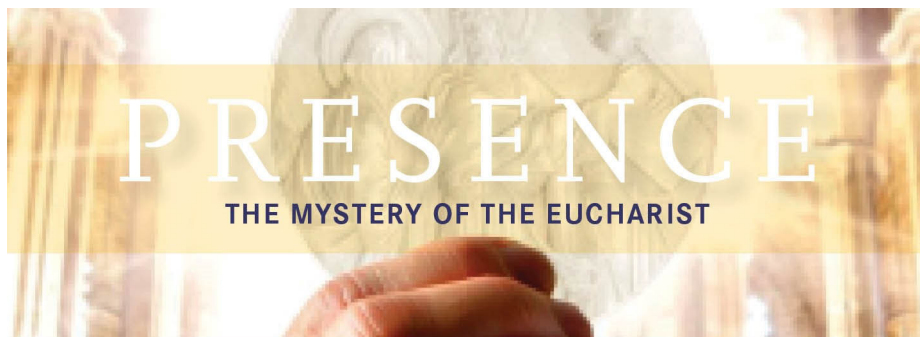

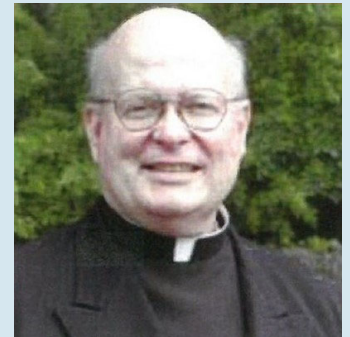
