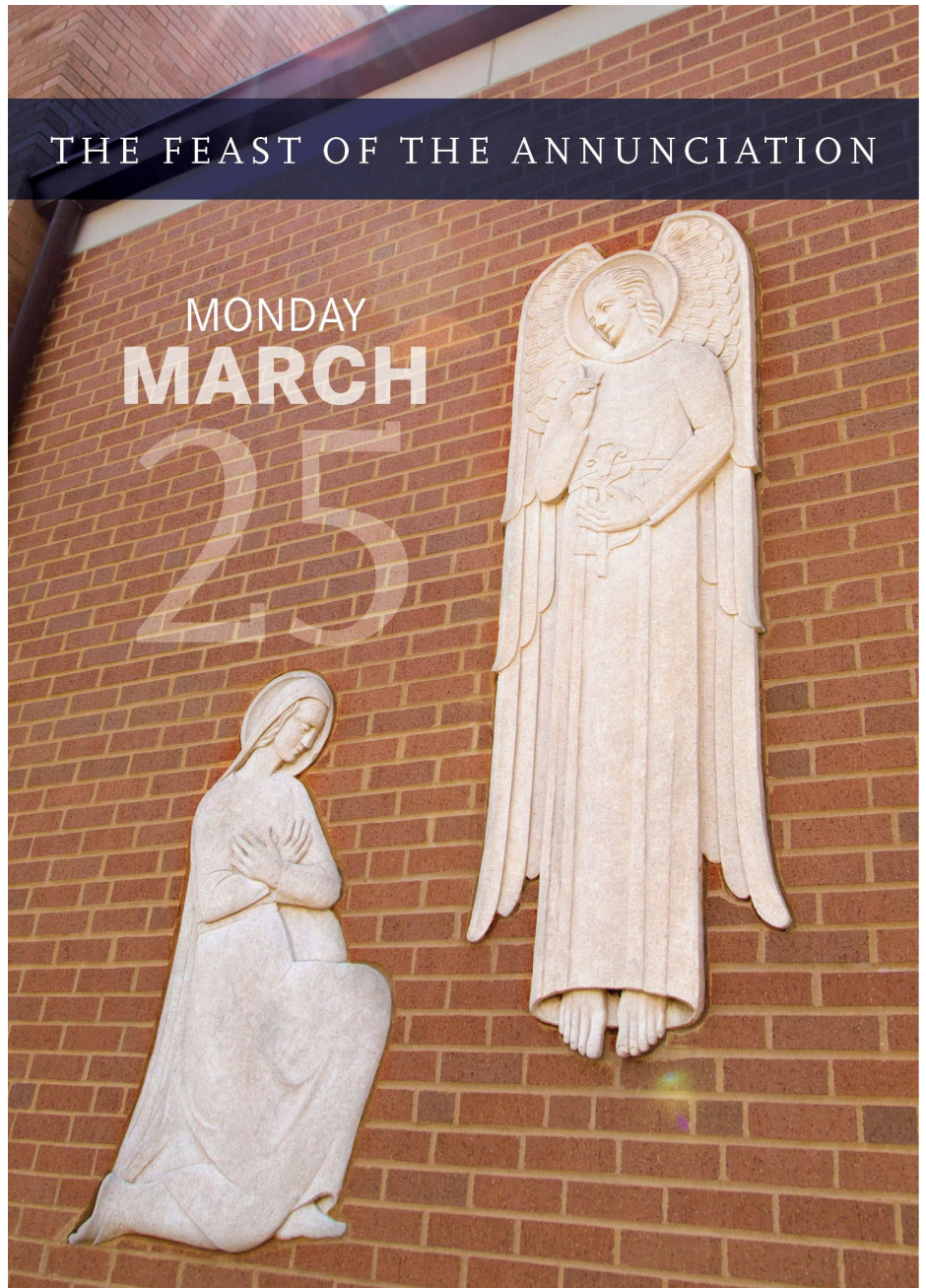

## MESSAGE FROM FATHER MIKE ESSWEIN

*Dear Friends,*

This week on Monday we celebrate our parish's Feast Day! For two of the last three years the celebration of the Annunciation was not held on its official date because in 2016 March 25<sup>th</sup> was Good Friday and last year in 2018 it was Palm Sunday. As a result in both of these years we celebrated the Annunciation on the Monday immediately following the Octave of Easter, that is, the Monday eight days after Easter Sunday. The reason we the Church celebrated the Annunciation on that Monday in both years is threefold:

First, it was moved to that Monday following the Octave of Easter because Easter and the days of the week leading up to it (Holy Week) and then those days of the week there following it (the Octave of Easter) held a higher claim on us for celebration. The days of Jesus' Passion tide and the subsequent days of His Resurrection are to be understood as more significant in the Story of our means to salvation than would be Gabriel's visit to Mary and Jesus' Incarnation.

Second, it was moved in both of those years to that Monday because it was the first available day following those Solemnity days of Easter to celebrate it.

Third, it was moved to those Mondays, simply put, because the Church says it's still worth celebrating! And, I would think we would all agree!!! Even when it gets superseded by the highest Holy Days of our salvation and it is not going to be held on March 25<sup>th</sup>, the Annunciation still remains most significant and important for the Church to have a day reserved for it's celebration. In most cases whatever celebrations happen to coincide with these days surrounding Easter, they simply get 'dropped' for a given year and are not celebrated at all with Mass. In the case of the Annunciation, like the days of Easter, it also holds the highest liturgical rank of a Solemnity and is never dropped off the Liturgical calendar in any year. One humorous way to consider it is, without the Annunciation there would be no Christmas, and if there was no Christmas, there would be no Santa Claus for a year, and there is no way there could ever be a year without Santa Claus coming to town!?! Ha!

In reality, we celebrate the Annunciation not only because it recalls for us Jesus becoming one with us at His conception, but we also celebrate it because it is the event by which we as a parish family are named and are known by all other communities and individuals of the Greater Saint Louis area. Just as the event of the Annunciation was the Angel Gabriel sharing Good News about Jesus with Mary, so, too, are we as a community of faith to be sharing the Good News about Jesus with everyone we go to and meet! We are Annunciation, and I hear from many in and outside of our community that we are a community that serves as good new for many others.

May the Lord continue to bless us, guide us, and inspire us to be messengers of His Good News as we celebrate this Monday, the Annunciation.
