SERVICE IN LOVE, eagerly fulfilling our love of God through supporting our neighbors in need.



Dear Friends,

Congratulations are in order for Jamie and Lynn Mealey of our parish. Jamie and Lynn will be honored at Holy Cross Academy's Gala on Saturday, November 16th, as the parishioners of Annunciation who are the 2019 Legacy Award Recipients. They are most deserving of this award that is given to a parishioner who exemplifies dedication, service, and true stewardship to the parish and the Academy. I will provide more detail about their award in the coming weeks but I wanted to let the parish know so that you can congratulate them or, if you are available, to make plans to attend the Gala so that you can be present when they receive the award itself that evening. It is going to be a great night and I'm happy for Jamie and Lynn.

As we begin the month of November, it is the month where we direct our attention in a more purposeful way in remembering our brothers and sisters who have fallen asleep in the hope of the Resurrection.

We began the month with the celebration of the Solemnity of All Saints on November 1st. This solemnity has us, the Church, remembering, celebrating, and asking for prayerful assistance of those members of the Communion of Saints who now live their lives in Heaven after living faith-filled and virtuous lives on earth. These Saints, as we name them, are able to serve and assist us as we live out our journeys on earth. Their exemplary lives, their recorded stories, and their words of teaching and preaching are sources for guidance and wisdom for us to tap into and to find support in living our lives of faith now. The fullness of life that they have found in Heaven is to be the destiny we will each share with them one day. We share with them now, though, the celebration of the Eucharist. To keep this in mind and help raise our hearts to our God, we have in our sanctuary during this month of November our four Patron Saints: Our Blessed Mother of the Annunciation, Saint Louis, Saint Vincent de Paul, and Saint Rose Philippine Duchesne.

One practice during this month that would be good for all of us to do would be to spend some time reading and learning about the lives of a few Saints whether that be these four Patrons of ours, or that be our individual Patron Saints, or our favorite Saints from childhood, or just randomly chosen Saints we find by going on-line in a search for Saints. Our heavenly friends are worth getting to know and if there is ever a time during the year to do so it would be now!

The day following all Saints is November 2nd, which is the day we celebrate the Feast of All Souls. It's also known as the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. On this day we remember and pray for, in a most particular way, our departed brothers and sisters in need of the purgation of their souls in preparation for eternal life in Heaven. We refer to this traditionally as, "praying for the poor souls in purgatory." Sometimes people question whether we *still* believe in purgatory, and, the answer is, 'Yes'. When anyone of us dies in this life, unless we have lived a most virtuous life in union with Christ that is nearly free from all sin, we will be in need of purgatory in order to have *purged from* ourselves our sinfulness and its effects that still clings to us upon death and, then, made ready to live an eternal life in union with God. Life in Heaven is a gift that will be given by God and not a foregone conclusion that we should feel entitled to experience. Eternal life in heaven was a promise Jesus gave to those who believe in Him and who strive to live their lives in accordance with his teachings and commandments, but it is never to be considered as something anyone of us is entitled to receive. It is by God's grace and mercy through His Son, Jesus, that any of us, the Saints included, come to know and live the life of Heaven. During November we offer our prayers for all of our deceased relatives and friends and parishioners in order to assist them in coming to know and experience the fullness of God's grace and mercy.

Throughout the month of November we will have the Book of the Dead in the front of the sanctuary where you are welcome to write the name(s) of your loved one(s) as we will lift them up with our prayers while asking the Saints to continue to pray for us.


