Guided by our relationship with Jesus Christ and inspired by the Holy Spirit, we fulfill our baptismal calling through:

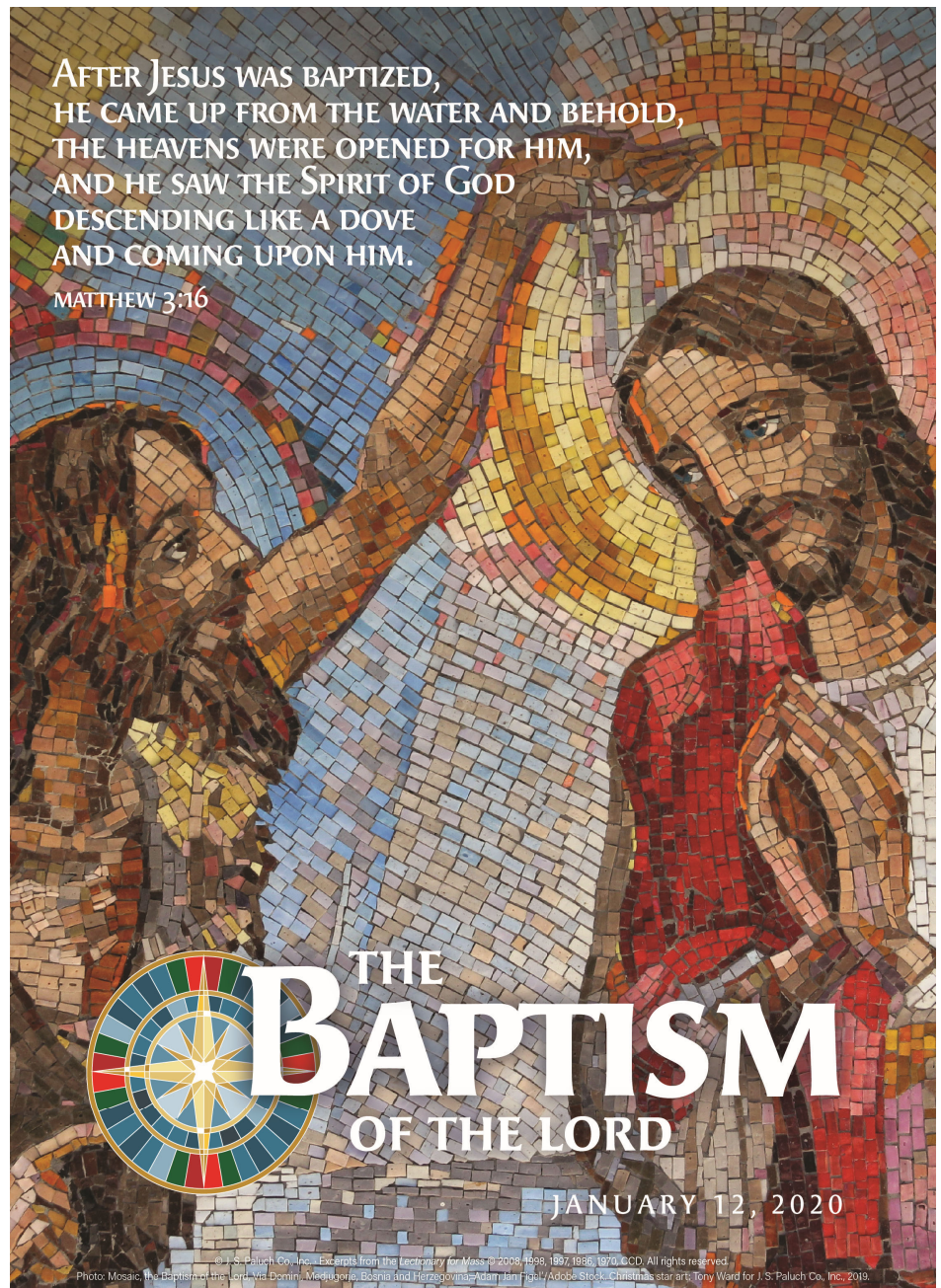
PRAYER, mindfully keeping the celebration of the Eucharist at the center of our lives as a community;

Dear Friends,

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Baptism of our Lord it brings to an end the Christmas Season.

We recognize how Jesus' baptism marked the end of His private life at home and gave way to His public life in announcing the Good News of Salvation to the world. On the day each of us were baptized we were *baptized - 'plunged'* - into the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Our baptisms in 'the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit' bathed us in the love and grace of God that freed us from Sin and promised us an eternal destiny with the hope of being forever united with our God in His Kingdom of eternal peace and love. Through baptism your personal timeline, and mine, was dramatically transformed, whereby, death would no longer be an end to your timeline but, instead, was now promised to be an event that would open you to an eternal one that is far greater and fuller than you or I would have known before or could ever imagine now. On the day we were each baptized, in a very real way, we were born into the beginning of eternal life. And, with all that was given and promised to us at our baptisms, we were each given a job to do in response, that is, His mission to announce the Good News of Salvation by our very lives.

If by chance you do not already know the date of your baptism, today or sometime this week would be a good time for you to find out. Once you discover it, put it in your calendar and think about how you might celebrate it each year. It's worth celebrating. It's your birthday into eternal life! You could celebrate it in any number of ways. Be creative. A few ideas would be...go to Mass or confession that day or simply say a prayer of gratitude for your gift of faith. You could make that day a day of reflection where you would consider the ways you see yourself living out your God given mission of announcing the Good News of Jesus Christ and how you want to specifically do it in the year ahead. You could take a trip to the church you were baptized and visit the font where the holy water was poured over your head; or, you could find your baptismal candle and light it as you eat dinner or say your nighttime prayers. The sky is the limit in the ways that any of us could celebrate our individual days of baptism, but it's worth keeping in mind because by your baptism the limit of the sky was shattered and Heaven became an eternal possibility for you and for me!

Each time I celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism I like to tell the family of what Saint Louis, the patron of our city and archdiocese, had written about baptism. It tells of the importance and significance of that Sacrament for every one of us. Saint Louis wrote:

"I think more of the place where I was baptized than of the place where I was crowned King of France, the Cathedral of Rheims, because when I die I will lose my title as king, but the place where I was baptized is where I received my passport to eternal life."

Here's to your baptism and to mine!

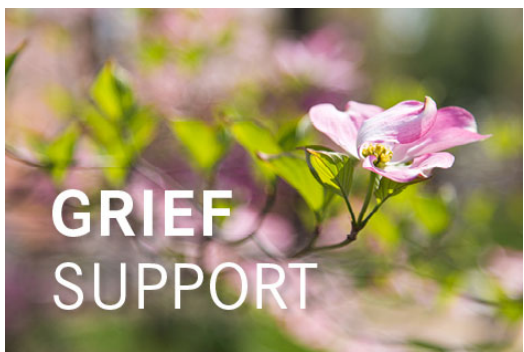
Eucharistic Adoration
