STEWARDSHIP, humbly giving our time, talent, and treasure to God and our community;

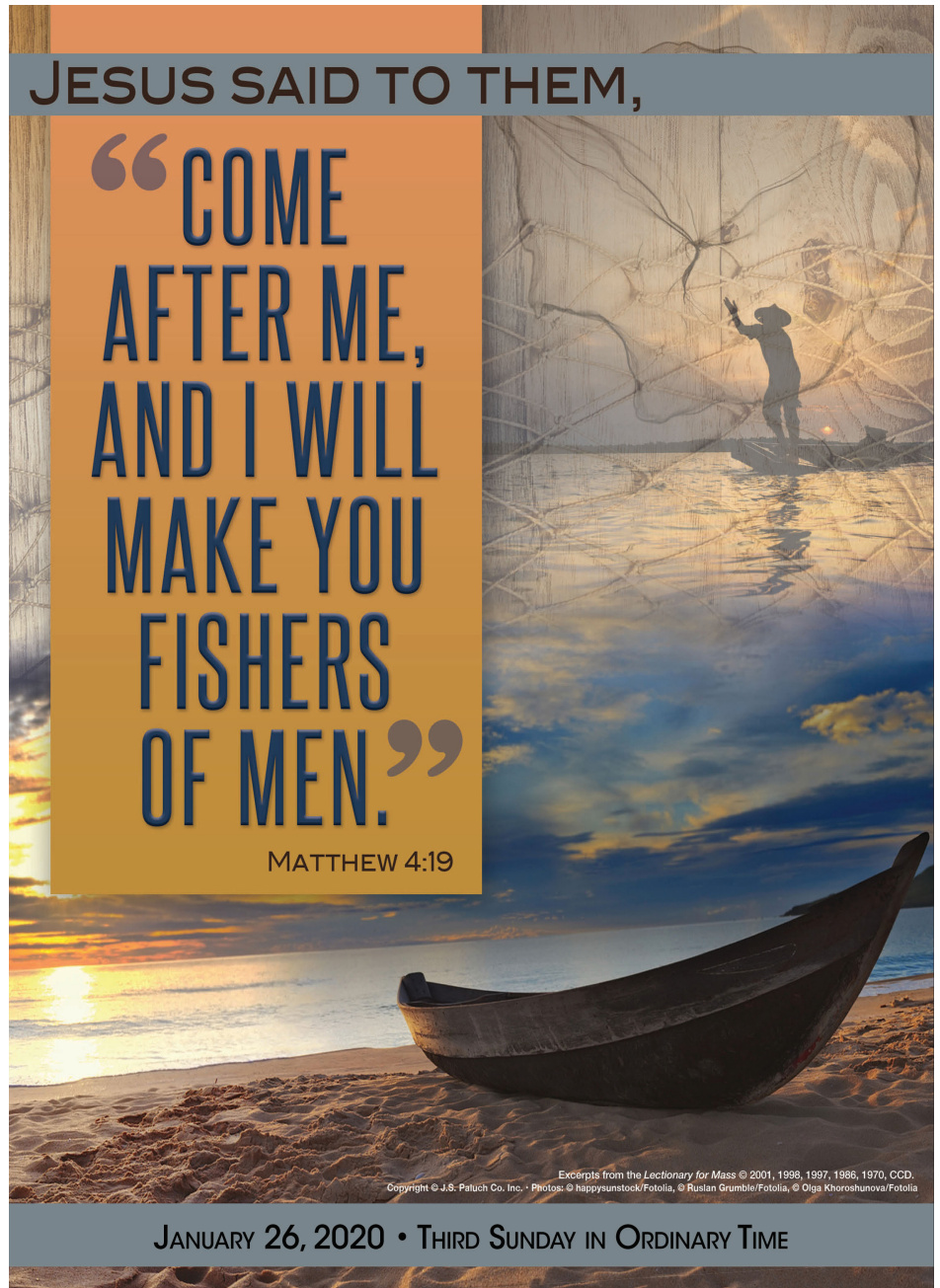

Dear Friends,

This week is Catholic Schools' Week. It's the one-week of the year when we celebrate Catholic schools throughout the Archdiocese of St. Louis. As a way to highlight and celebrate our parish school, we had invited our parishioner-students to help lead us in worship at the 10 AM Mass in the various liturgical roles. I want to thank all of the students of our parish who attend our school, Holy Cross Academy, and who volunteered to serve as one of the many liturgical ministers. Also as part of Catholic Schools' Week, this Sunday we are having an Open House from 10 AM -1 PM at all four of our campuses. If you haven't seen any of our campuses, you might enjoy taking the time on this Sunday to visit them. With the new structure beginning this fall, each of our campuses will be providing information that will highlight the benefits and differences that will be experienced at our Early Childhood Education Campus (St. John Paul II), our K-2 Primary Campus (St. Michael the Archangel), our 3-5 Intermediate Campus (Our Lady of Providence), as well as our Middle School Campus right here at Annunciation. I thank all of you who support our Catholic school throughout the year in so many ways.

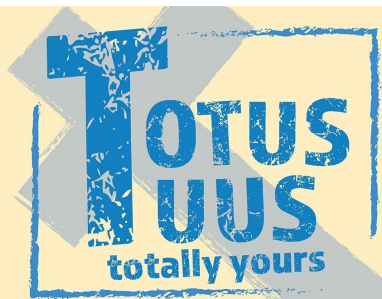

Attention Parish Volunteers

New System for Safe Environment Compliance

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. Everyone (clergy, employees and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 1, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who attend a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to the new system (if your class date does not transfer in, contact Barb Koch in Parish Office). In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children Workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Go to www.preventandprotectstl.org to register. The passcode is *stlprotect*. Please contact **Barb Koch** in the parish office (parishsecretary@goannunciation.com or 314-962-5955, x121) with any questions or for further assistance. It takes about 30 minutes to fully complete all steps required to register and to be in full compliance in the new system.
