Dear Friends,

It's the month of February. I remember during my years as a college and graduate student in the seminary, the month of February always seemed to be the longest month of the year. Even though I knew it had the fewest days of all the months of the year, there was something about this month that encompassed this time of the year when winter had settled in, and the days were frequently gray, and spring was still a good number of weeks away, and the days just had a tendency for me to seemingly drag along or felt as if they somehow were moving slower than any other time of the year. And, then, once every four years, like this year, the 'longest month of the year' would pick up one additional day to add to its length for a total of 29 days!?! Over the years I came to an insight as to why this month may have had this feeling of being the longest month. I realized that in addition to its long winter days, unlike the majority of the other months of the year, February had no significant events or celebrations that I was anticipating, looking forward to, or making plans for to get ready—minus that of Ash Wednesday in some years. There were no events that naturally broke up the day-to-day, week-to-week happenings in my life, and subsequently the month just felt longer than all the others despite the fact that it was always the shortest! If my experience of February back then describes your experience of February now, I have for you a couple of events that I would recommend you put into your calendar today which will break up any humdrum feelings you might have that comes with a February filled with a continuum of days of doing the same old thing. Here's how Sign Up Parties Work:

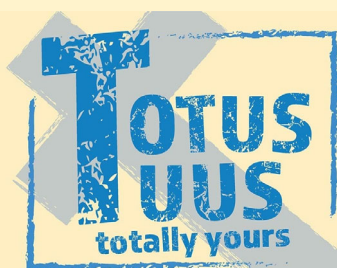

Attention Parish Volunteers

New System for Safe Environment Compliance

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called **Prevent and Protect STL**. Everyone (clergy, employees and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 1, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who attend a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to the new system (if your class date does not transfer in, contact Barb Koch in Parish Office). In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children Workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Go to

www.preventandprotectstl.org to register. *The passcode is stlprotect*. Please contact **Barb Koch** in the parish office (parishsecretary@goannunciation.com or 314-962-5955, x121) with any questions or for further assistance. It takes about 30 minutes to fully complete all steps required to register and to be in full compliance in the new system.

Many of you have registered on the site and submitted a background check but have neglected to complete the other requirements. Here are the steps that everyone must complete:

- Register onto the site
- Submit New Background Check
- Complete "Protecting God's Children" training (For those in the old system you class date should transfer in. If not please call or email me and I can fix that)
- Complete "Mandated Reporter" training
- Complete "Code of Conduct" training
- Sign electronically the "Code of Conduct"
