MESSAGE FROM FATHER MIKE ESSWEIN

Dear Friends,

At the Parish Council meeting earlier this week, one of the topics we discussed was the season of Lent, which begins in less than 2 weeks. In this discussion we considered the three traditional practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. As we talked, we explored some ideas in how we could possibly engage all of you in discovering different and new ways in living out those three practices that we routinely do during Lent. One idea that we decided we would present to the parish was to ask you to share with us on-line resources, such as websites, daily/weekly emails, podcasts, etc., that you have personally found to be fruitful for your own prayer life, reflection, or understanding of the faith. The parish council liked the idea of collecting your recommended resources that you have found helpful in your individual spiritual lives, so that they could then be shared collectively with our entire community. This collection of resource would be organized and shared with all of you so that we would all have an opportunity to consider new ideas in living out the practice of prayer during Lent, and at the same time become more and more the *prayerful community of Annunciation* (see our Mission statement). If you have a resource that you have found helpful in the past and think that maybe others may find helpful, too, please send your recommendations to Katie Rengel (PC member) drury.kathryn@gmail.com, as well as a brief reason of what you found to be so good or helpful about this particular resource. We may include your reason alongside your recommended resource in order to provide everyone some idea of what they might expect if they were to choose this one for Lent. If you would prefer to remain anonymous or do not care to give a reason for your recommendation, you can simply mention this, too. We hope to have a list of resources to share with you for Ash Wednesday so please send your recommendations to Katie this week.

EVANGELIZATION

What is the “Jonah Prayer Ministry” and When do They Meet?

The Jonah team prays after the 10 am Mass each Sunday except for the 2nd Sunday when we meet after 8am Mass (in Fr Mike's confessional room in the back of church). Jonah Prayer Ministry is a prayer ministry based at the parish level. The goal is for every parish to have a Jonah Prayer Ministry or its equivalent. Praying with each other is an excellent way to affirm each other's faith as a community, to let the Holy Spirit heal our hurts and to open our eyes to being thankful for the truth and love in every situation that we experience. Jonah Prayer Ministers are people like yourself who are approved by the pastor for this ministry. Ministry members feel the call to pray for others or desire to use their spiritual gifts of prayer given to them by the Holy Spirit. After training Jonah Prayer ministers pray in small groups with individuals who request prayer support, maintaining confidence in all matter. Ministry sessions are scheduled according to individual parish activity and with pastoral approval. In summary, Jonah Prayer Ministry is another beautiful way that the Holy Spirit can have profound direct spiritual impact both in the parish community and in personal lives. Jonah Prayer Ministry is about being present to fellow parishioners through prayer and praying with expectant faith knowing God brings about transformation/healing/growth.
