**Farewell Archbishop Carlson!
Welcome Archbishop-Elect
Rozanski as the 10th
Archbishop of Saint Louis!**

Wednesday morning, the Holy Father announced the acceptance of the letter of retirement presented by Archbishop Robert Carlson and appointed Mitchell T. Rozanski, until now Bishop of Springfield in Massachusetts, as Archbishop of Saint Louis. Bishop Mitchell Thomas Rozanski was born on August 6, 1958 in Baltimore (Maryland). He

attended Sacred Heart of Mary primary school in Baltimore, and Our Lady of Mount Carmel High School secondary school in Essex. He completed his studies in Philosophy and Theology at the Theological College of the Catholic University of America in Washington (1978-1984). He was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Baltimore on November 24, 1984. After priestly ordination, he held the following positions: Parish Vicar of Saint Michael Parish in Overlea (1984-1986), Saint Anthony of Padua Parish in Baltimore (1986-1990), Parish priest of Saint Isaac Jogues Parish in Baltimore (1990 -1993) and of the twin parishes Holy Cross and Saint Mary Star of the Sea Parishes in Baltimore (1993-2000) and of the Saint John the Evangelist Parish in Severna Park (2000-2004). He was also Vicar Forane in Anne Arundel County and Member of the College of Consultors, of the Presbyteral Council, of the Archdiocesan Committee for Vocations, of the Priest Personnel Board, the Clergy Permanent Formation Committee and the Lay Formation Committee. He was Vicar for Hispanic Ministers in Baltimore. He served as Auxiliary Bishop of Baltimore on 3 July 2004, and was consecrated a bishop on August 24. He was transferred to the Diocese of Springfield, Massachusetts on June 19, 2014 and took office on August 12, 2014. Within the Episcopal Conference he is a member of the Committee on Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs. More details will be emerging about the date of Bishop Rozanski's installation as Archbishop. Let us pray for Archbishop Carlson as he enters retirement and pray for our new Archbishop-elect as he prepares to move to St. Louis.

Dear Friends,

As you saw on the front of the bulletin the next Archbishop for us has been named by Pope Francis and he will begin being our shepherd on the Feast of Saint Louis when he is installed on August 25th. As we await his arrival let us pray for both Archbishop Carlson and Bishop Rozanski in this time of their transitions to new beginnings.

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ it certainly is most unusual and feels strange given our current set of circumstances. Each year the Solemnity provides us a pause so as to reflect on how special the gift of the Eucharist is for you and me. This year we have had more than a pause allowing all of us to really consider the Eucharist because of its absence in our communal lives and your individual lives. Because of this It makes me very happy to confirm with you that we will be celebrating our first public Mass next Sunday at 9 AM. We will have it outside on the back parking lot and we will hope and pray that the weather cooperates. We will be sending you specific details on the guidelines later this week. The guidelines will provide information as well as the procedures that we will all need to follow in order to keep us all safe.

I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You.

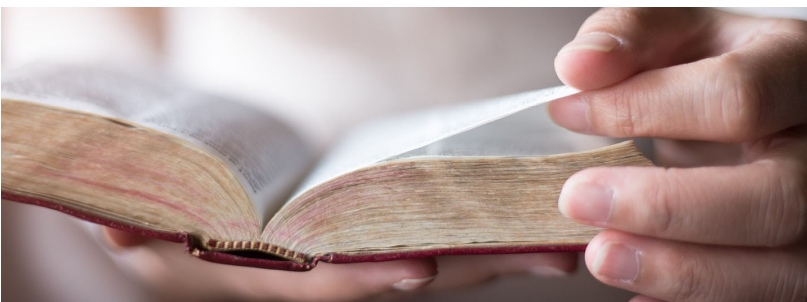
Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

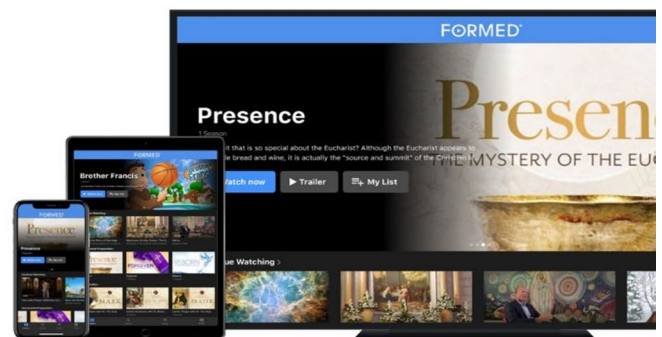
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
