EVANGELIZATION, actively sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ with those around us;



Learning about the Saints

PSR classes have flown by this first month! The children have participated in several fun learning activities already, most especially centered on the Sunday Gospels and the Saints. 3rd and 6th Grade families celebrated the Feast Day of Saint Jerome with a special prayer service in church. Saint Jerome, a Doctor of the Church, translated the Bible into Latin in the Vulgate. The students received their very own Bibles which were then blessed by Fr. Mike. The families were led through a Lectio Divina and Visio Divina prayer reflection where they were able to hear and see the Word of God. The students and parents then spent time in reflection and discussion on the image shown here from the Saint John’s Bible depicting an illustration on Creation. Many of the families shared how they encountered God through this illuminated image. It was a great family event that ended with cookies and socializing outside!

Awaiting Joy


