- if married, must be in a valid marriage, sacramentally married by a priest or deacon.

I am grateful to all our parishioners who serve the parish in this ministry. We are all blessed by their reverent and faithful service.

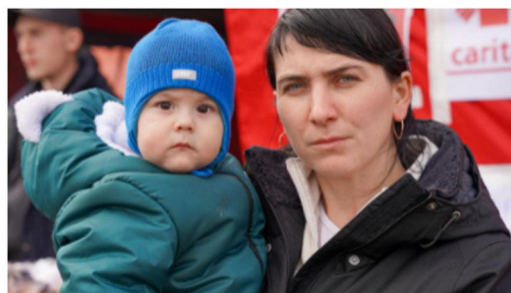

Who we are: The Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu (LSMIG) are an indigenous Congregation of Catholic Sisters founded in 1936 in the Archdiocese of Gulu in Northern Uganda(East Africa).

Our Mission: LSMIG are called to witness to the love of Jesus Christ to most vulnerable especially women, children, youth and the senior members of the society. We the LSMIG live our mission through: Catholic education, health, pastoral and social services to the poor and the most vulnerable members in the society.

Our Ministry: Since 2016, the LSMIG are responding to a unique

ministry to a people who are recovering from four decades of civil war (1979-2016), while concurrently dealing with influx of refugees from neighboring South Sudan and the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). The traumatic impact of the war coupled with the global crisis of COVID 19 and lack of access to vaccines, has generated untold humanitarian crisis in northern Uganda. The COVID19 lockdown exposed refugee girls and boys to domestic and sexual violence & forced early marriage. The girls in particular are given to early marriage in exchange for money and animals to meet basic needs of the other members of family. Consequently, these girls have become child mothers at the tender age of 13-16 years. Without catholic health services and education, these girls and their babies are prone to more violence and exploitation.

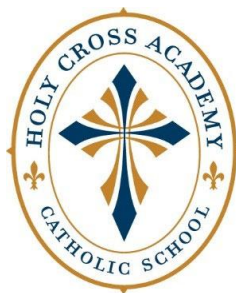
Need a Ride to Mass or a Holy Communion Visit
