MESSAGE FROM FATHER MIKE ESSWEIN

Dear Friends,

A few months ago I told you about the All Things New survey that everyone in the Archdiocese 14 yrs of age and older were being invited and encouraged to take. This survey was part of the process for understanding the overall and collective experience that is both ours as the local, Catholic Church and Faith community, as well as of our own individual parishes.

Some good information was discovered and learned through the survey in which 70,718 individuals, about 60% of Mass-going Catholics, of the Archdiocese participated. For Annunciation, 349 of you completed the survey which is about 87% of our Mass-going Catholics. The data collected and results of the survey for u as the Church of Saint Louis can be found at allthingsnew.archstl.org/Survey-Results. You can also find this information by going to allthingsnew.archstl.org/ and then selecting the “Survey Results” tab at the top and scrolling down to the bottom of that page.

The information and data that was collected for each individual parish has been shared with its pastor and parish ATN committee members, also known as the Key Parish Leaders. Each pastor along with his parish’s ATN committee has been given a couple of weeks to review the information, complete a workbook of additional questions, and give an assessment and summary of what the survey revealed. Earlier this week after reviewing together the information over a couple meetings our committee completed the workbook and provided our assessment to the ATN and Archdiocese.

In the next week or two I will provide a report for you on the information and data you provided as a group by taking the survey about our parish.

In the meantime, let us continue to pray for the success of this most important initiative for the future of our Church as the Archdiocese of St. Louis.

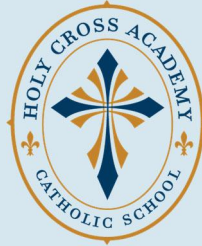

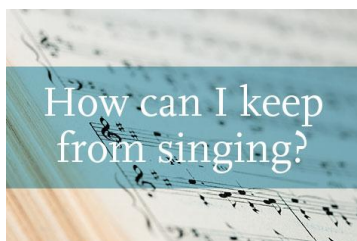

Who we are: The Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu (LSMIG) are an indigenous Congregation of Catholic Sisters founded in 1936 in the Archdiocese of Gulu in Northern Uganda(East Africa).

Our ministry to a people who are recovering from four decades of civil war (1979-2016), while concurrently dealing with influx of refugees from neighboring South Sudan and the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). The traumatic impact of the war coupled with the global crisis of COVID 19 and lack of access to vaccines, has generated untold humanitarian crisis in northern Uganda. The COVID19 lockdown exposed refugee girls and boys to domestic and sexual violence & forced early marriage. The girls in particular are given to early marriage in exchange for money and animals to meet basic needs of the other members of family. Consequently, these girls have become child mothers at the tender age of 13-16 years. Without catholic health services and education, these girls and their babies are prone to more violence and exploitation.
