


## MAY THEY REST IN PEACE

Dear Friends,

It's amazing how quickly the season of Christmas has come and gone! This year we had the shortest Advent and Christmas seasons possible as Christmas landed on a Monday. I guess it should come as no surprise that this season of Ordinary Time will also be brief before the season of Lent begins on February 14th. Yes, Ash Wednesday lands on Valentine's Day this year! Subsequently, we will celebrate Easter on the last day of March. Despite how quickly celebrations may seemingly come, and go, we remember the message of Christmas, that Jesus is Emmanuel, God with us. And, this is true in every season, but what we're called to do is to strive to always be with Him. May we keep our efforts in prayer and service to others always in the forefront of our minds and hearts.

On Monday as our Nation celebrates *Martin Luther King, Jr Day*, we remember his call for racial equality when he stated in his *I Have a Dream* speech, "I have a dream that my four children will one day, live in a nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin, but by the content of their character." Dr. King's call is echoed in the Catechism which states: "Created in the image of the one God and equally endowed with rational souls, all men have the same nature and the same origin. Redeemed by the sacrifice of Christ, all are called to participate in the same divine beatitude: all therefore enjoy an equal dignity." (CCC 1934). Dr. King's message of equality back in 1968 is rooted in the Gospel passage of the Golden Rule. "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you" (Mt 7:12). As our Nation remembers its history in defending human rights and ending discrimination against people of all races and creeds, may we stay rooted in Jesus' law of love in every interaction we have with all those we meet and continue to pray for that day when we will all be one in Christ Jesus our Lord.




## RCIA

The **James J. Slama Scholarship Foundation** was established in 2018 to help families in his parish and/or at Holy Cross Academy pay for Catholic high school. The Foundation raises money through the annual Slamapalooza festival in the summer, Give STL Day in May, Giving Tuesday in November, trivia night, and donations.

We currently award one Super Scholarship each year, one runner-up scholarship, and one Boy Scout scholarship. The Super Scholarship is a \$5000 award, renewable for all 4 years of high school. The runner-up scholarship is a one-time \$2000 award. The Boy Scout award is for an 8<sup>th</sup> grade boy in Troop 725 for \$750. Each year's winners are announced in May and awards are sent to the schools in July. As of this year, we have dispersed \$77,000 in scholarship money to students from St. John Paul II, St. Michael's, Our Lady of Providence, and Annunciation parishes.




