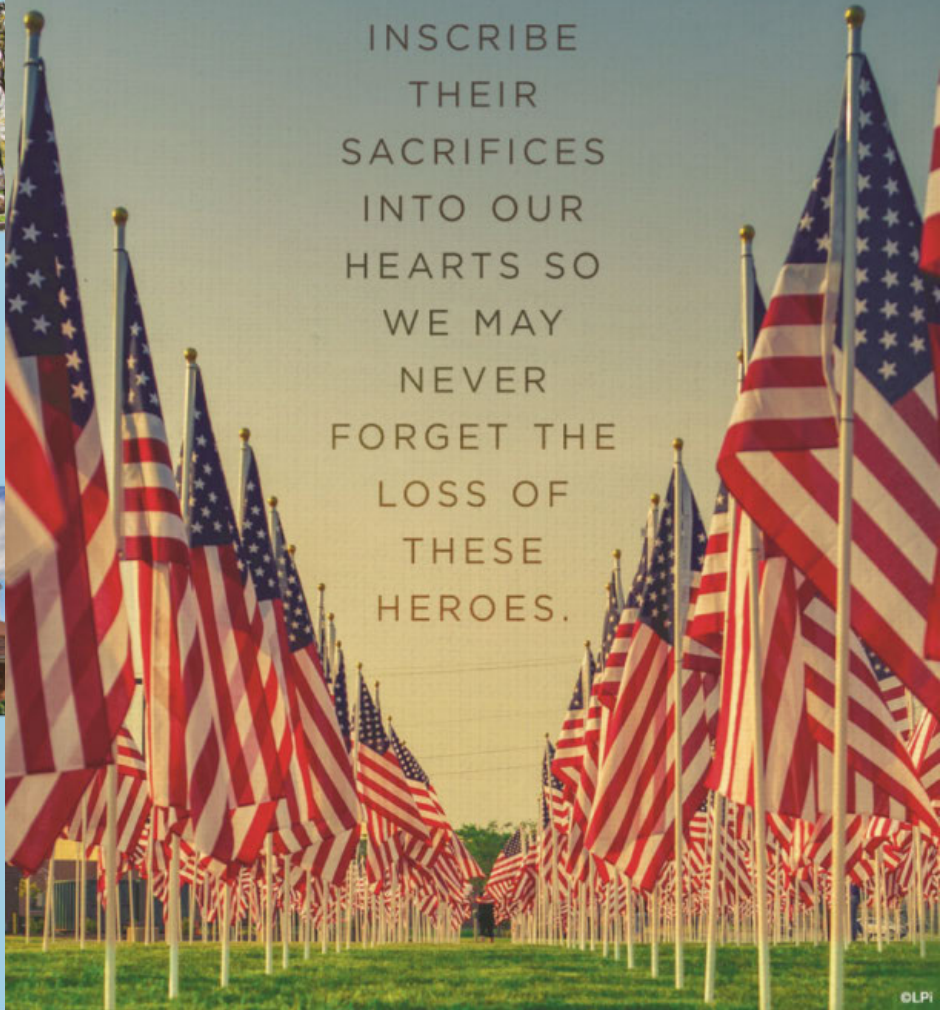

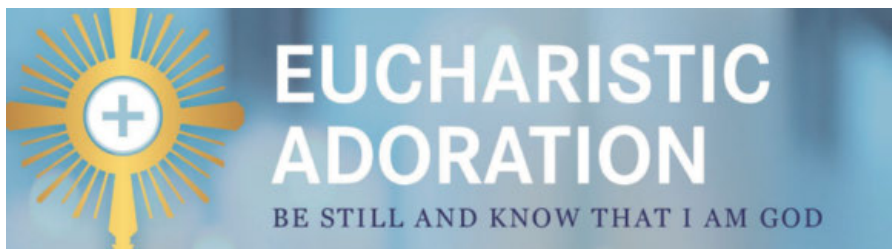

He knew them by name and checked in on the sports, activities and clubs they were in. Clark's family was deeply involved in the district, and his leadership made Webster Groves one of the best communities in the area. Humble and selfless, he would prefer this award go to someone else, but that's exactly why he deserves the Heart of Gold. "Dr. Clark is a wonderful human being that has been a pillar in the Webster Groves community," Clark's nomination said.

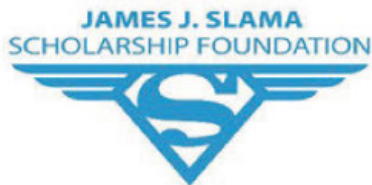

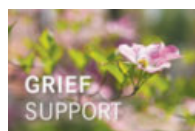

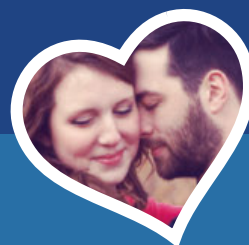
