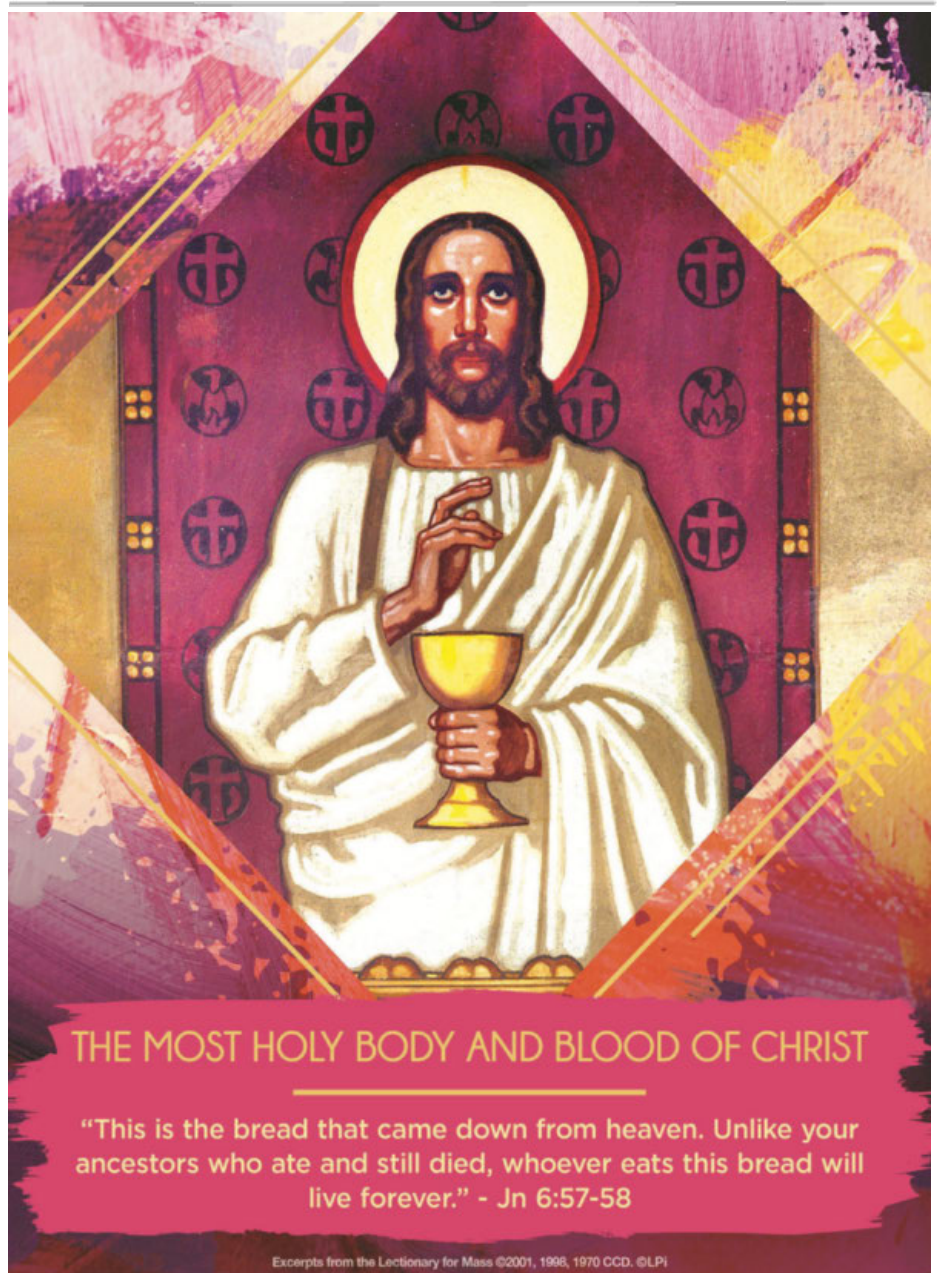

During the month of June, we honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We invite you to join us in praying the Sacred Heart of Jesus Novena. Pray all of the following prayers each day for nine days, from June 19– June 27.

Prayer One: O my Jesus, you have said: “Truly I say to you, ask and you will receive, seek and you will find, knock and it will be opened to you.” Behold I know, I seek, and ask for the grace of (request).

Then: *Our Father, Haily Mary, Glory Be.* Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place my trust in you. Amen

Prayer Two: O my Jesus, you have said: “Truly I say to you, if you ask anything of the Father in my name, he will give it to you.” Behold in your name, I ask the Father for the grace of (request).

Then: *Our Father, Haily Mary, Glory Be.* Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place my trust in you. Amen

Prayer Three: O my Jesus, you have said: “Truly I say to you, heaven and earth will pass away but my words will not pass away.” Encouraged by your infallible words, I now ask for the grace of (request).

Then: *Our Father, Haily Mary, Glory Be.* Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place my trust in you. Amen.

Concluding Prayer: O Sacred Heart of Jesus, for whom it is impossible not to have compassion on the afflicted, have pity on us miserable sinners and grant us the grace which we ask of you, through the Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, your tender Mother and ours. Amen



Dear Friends,

These last two weekends Father Paul and I invited you to prayerfully consider signing up to be a participant of the Archbishop's initiative: *Missionaries of Joy*. This invitation is truly meant for everyone in our parishes. I am excited to have such a great opportunity for you and our parish! This year-long program will provide each participant a deeper understanding of our Catholic faith, and, will subsequently, help cultivate a vibrant culture of evangelization in our two parishes.

Evangelization is the fundamental call given to each of us by Jesus at Baptism to announce the Good News to others. Nurturing a personal relationship with Christ with prayer and with study is what it means to be a disciple. The Missionaries of Joy program is a 12-course, online study, following a monthly formation schedule, taught by Augustine Institute professors in an engaging, self-paced, and in-depth format. Each month your commitment will be just 3-4 hours of guided reading and study, presented by video, by some of the best teachers of today.

This program does not require you to be a brilliant student. It simply requires an interest to learn a little bit more about our Catholic faith, and a desire to grow in one's relationship with the Lord. By having a group of individuals in this program at both parishes, it will help us cultivate a culture of missionary disciples that will transform our parishes for the future.

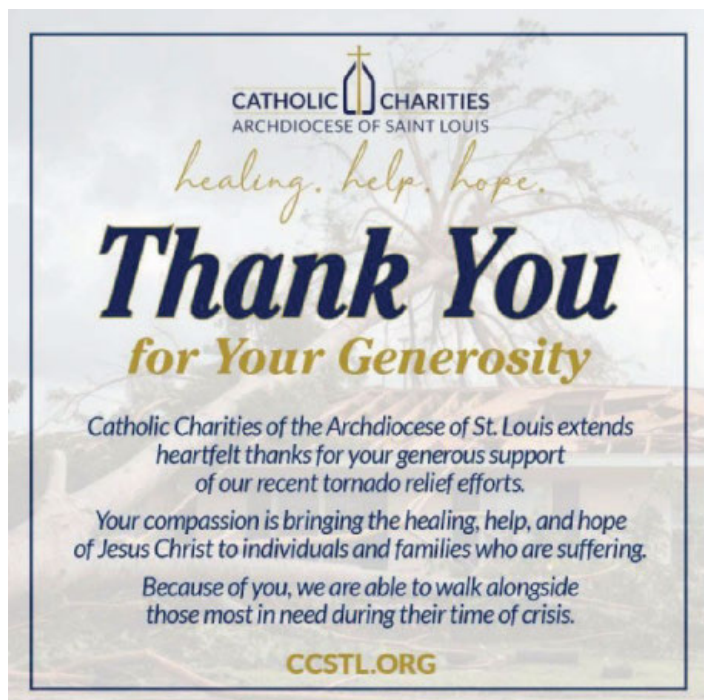

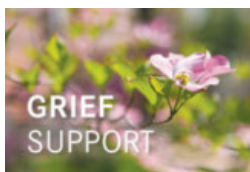

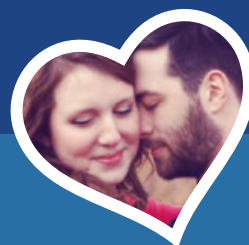
