



More than 328,500 Missouri Households Face Food Insecurity

The USDA's latest report finds that more than 328,500 Missouri households experience food insecurity at some point during the year. Those with low food security (nearly 178,500 households) cannot afford balanced meals and reduce the variety and nutritional quality of the food they purchase at times during the year.

Those with very low food security (more than 150,000 households) cut or skip meals at times during the year, usually in three or more months. The OLP Society of St. Vincent de Paul provides food vouchers and works with local food pantries to assist our Neighbors in Need. 
