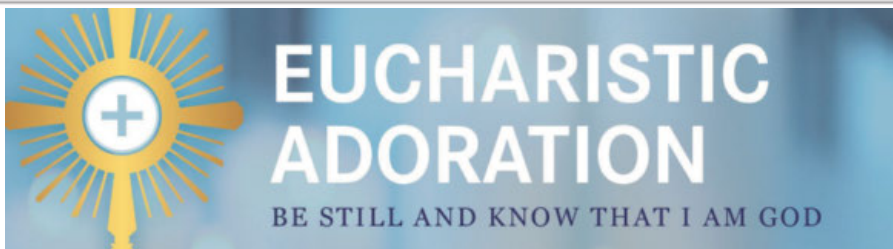

Dear Friends,

I'm happy and excited to report that over 50 members of our two parishes signed up for the Missionaries of Joy program! Each month for the next 12 months all participants will dedicate 3 to 4 hours to on-line viewing, reading, and study on a specific topic of our Catholic faith. These online courses will be taught by some of the best teachers of our day in the Catholic Church who work for the Augustine Institute. Each course will build upon the previous courses so at the end of the study, next June, each participant will receive a certification in theology. Additionally it is the expectation and hope that each individual will grow spiritually and intellectually from this year of study. I think it's exciting to have so many individuals in our community sharing in this one study. It is my hope that this study will greatly benefit our community as a whole helping us to grow in deeper appreciation for our mission to be communities of missionary disciples for the Lord!

Fundamental to the success of this program will be entrusting this initiative to God through prayer. So, whether you are one of the 50+ in the program or not, I would ask for your prayers for the success of this initiative to take root in the hearts and minds of those participating and in our greater two communities as a whole. Please keep this initiative in your daily prayers by offering an intention for it each morning or evening when you say your prayers, or by offering a decade of a rosary, or by spending some time in Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. Let us together invite the Holy Spirit to enliven us in Christ and transform our communities into Missionaries of Joy!

There is still time to register for Missionaries of Joy if you're still considering it as a possibility. The final deadline date is July 31.

Last weekend we enjoyed having Blest Art at Providence and next weekend (July 19th-20th) they will be at Annunciation. The works of art done in olive wood are truly beautiful. Additionally, each purchase helps Christians in the Holy Land, who are in desperate need of maintaining their livelihoods at a time when much of the tourism has come to a stop because of the recent war. If you missed the opportunity to peruse through all of their artwork last weekend at Providence, you will have a second opportunity at Annunciation next weekend following all of the weekend Masses.

All women and men of Our Lady of Providence and Annunciation are invited to attend a 2-day Labor Day

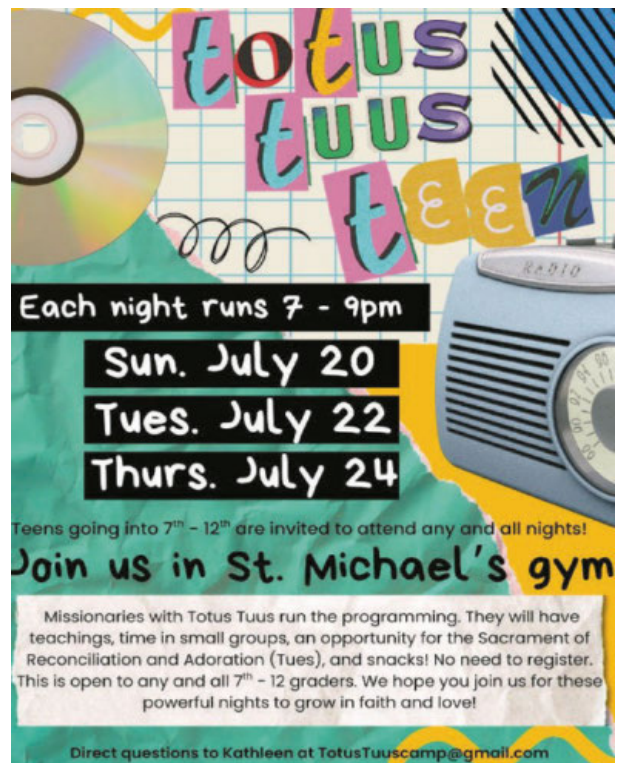
weekend retreat at White House Jesuit Retreat Center, located in South County. This will be a guided retreat with a director, usually a Jesuit Priest, who will base the retreat on the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius. This retreat is flexible with all activities being optional, allowing you to make your own retreat. You are given a schedule of what's available, and there are no surprises. It's like a 3-day vacation with Christ on their beautiful 80-acre campus that overlooks the bluffs of the Mississippi River. The retreat begins with check-in on Friday, August 29, from 5:00p.m.-6:15p.m. and concludes Sunday, August 31, with a 2:00p.m. departure time (allowing time to enjoy other plans the rest of the holiday weekend). If you need to arrive later or leave sooner, simply notify your retreat captain, Ann Kelly, before retreat day. There is no set fee to attend. The White House operates on a free will offering basis, asking those in attendance to simply give what they feel they can at the conclusion of the retreat. Meals and lodging are included. Lodging includes a private bathroom with a private shower. Meals are served family style, and there are opportunities for discussion and fellowship after dinner (optional social hour). Mass is celebrated both Saturday and Sunday. You may register directly on the Jesuit White House Retreat Center website (here is a shortcut to the online registration form): <https://share.google/hnr9F54Jh64XARiz3>. You will need the retreat date and group name which is: Annunciation and Our Lady of Providence. There is no need for a \$50 deposit if you register with the group. Spots fill up quickly, so register by 7/28 or you may be added to their waiting list. 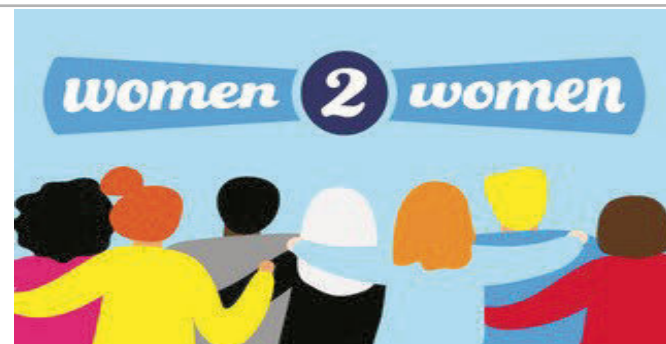

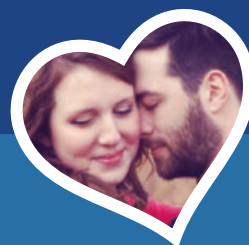
