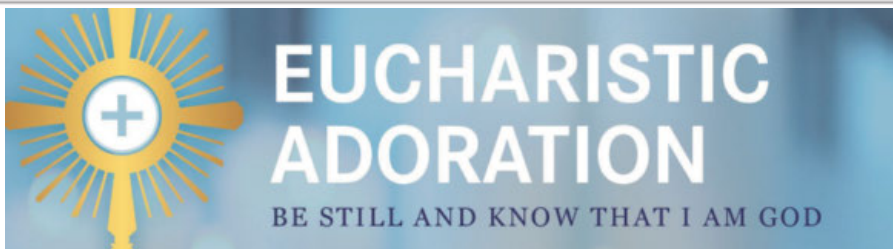

Friends of Honduras Update

Two weeks ago, we returned from our Medical mission trip, where we served the desperately poor communities in a remote, mountainous region of Honduras near the border of El Salvador. The villages we served were Guanacaste and Aguacate. Homes are scattered throughout the mountains, there is no running water, electricity, trucks or cars in the villages. Our mission is two-fold. We have a medical team and a community development team. We strive for excellence in each endeavor, holding ourselves to the same high standards as we would in the United States. This year was so special with the addition of Fr. Paul. He brought a rare opportunity for the communities to have a priest celebrate Mass in both villages. He also traveled up the mountain to visit and anoint an 88 year old woman, and served as a translator in Pharmacy. Colleen Wheadon, a pediatric intensive care nurse, and daughter of Deacon Pat Wheadon, lent her skills to both the Medical and Pharmacy departments with such ease and grace. What an asset she was to the team and those she served! She's already talking about going next year! While we were there, we saw over 1,500 patients. About 10% of those we saw were from other villages. Some walked up to 6 hours to reach us. No one is ever turned away. Since we began our work in the villages, we have tried different methods for the delivery of clean water. I am pleased to announce that on our plane trip home, one of our nurses sat next to a nun who runs a program for clean water. It is called Water by Women. We have already begun the process, signed the convenient, and are well on our way to providing clean water for both villages! Truly, this could only happen through prayer and the work of the Holy Spirit! For more details about our trip and examples of what your funding has provided, please see this week's

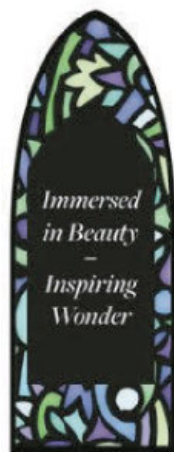

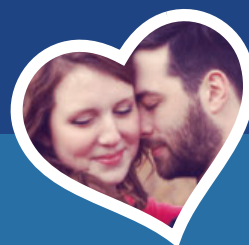
